

Master of Project Management - Minor in Faith-Based Organizational Leadership

HBI University

Course Duration: 2 years

Credit Hours: 69 (including 15 credit hours for minor)



Program Description

The Master of Project Management at HBI University provides students with advanced training in project execution, stakeholder engagement, and organizational leadership. The program integrates strategic planning, financial management, and operational efficiency to prepare graduates for leadership roles in corporate, nonprofit, and faith-based settings.

The Minor in Faith-Based Organizational Leadership offers a specialized focus on church and nonprofit management, ethical leadership, and team-building strategies. Students will explore biblical leadership principles, mission-driven project development, and financial stewardship in ministry settings.

This 69-credit hour program includes 30 credit hours of foundational project management courses, 24 credit hours of core leadership courses, 15 credit hours in Faith-Based Organizational Leadership, elective coursework, a supervised practicum, and a research-based master's thesis.

Admissions Requirements

- Bachelor's degree in business, management, or a related field
- Minimum GPA of 3.0
- Two letters of recommendation from faculty or business professionals
- Statement of purpose outlining career goals in business, project management, and faith-based leadership
- Resume or Curriculum Vitae (CV)
- Interview with faculty committee (if required)

Practicum Requirement

Students must complete a 300-hour supervised practicum in corporate project leadership, nonprofit administration, or faith-based organizational management. Practicum placements include church organizations, humanitarian initiatives, and corporate project teams.

Master's Thesis

Students are required to complete a research-based master's thesis exploring strategic project execution, nonprofit management, or leadership in faith-based institutions. The thesis should provide applied research with real-world case studies and project implementation models.

Program Outcomes

- Graduates of this program will be able to:
- Lead large-scale projects in business, nonprofit, and faith-based organizations.
- Apply faith-based leadership strategies to organizational development.
- Utilize financial, risk, and resource management principles effectively.
- Integrate Christian ethics and servant leadership into business and ministry settings.
- Develop sustainable growth strategies for nonprofit and faith-driven initiatives.

- Faith-Based Organizational Director – \$60,000 - \$125,000

- Church Administrator & Operations Manager – \$65,000 - \$120,000
