

SEC Swimming Game Sheet

Start Times:

All Division meets will begin at 6:00 p.m.

Pre-Game Warm-up:

• The pool will be available at least 60 minutes prior to the start of the meet

Meet Format:

- Electronic entries file shall be submitted by coaches prior to the dual meet
- Coaches agree that alterations of the line-up may take place in accordance with the National Federation rules
- All dual meets will use six-lane scoring; alternate scoring may be used if agreed upon in advance (at least 24 hours) by both teams
- In diving, judging shall be done by one coach from each team and one official, or by one coach and two officials

General Procedures:

- When a host school conducts a special activity that will interrupt the meet, they shall be required to notify the visiting AD and/or coach no later than upon arrival
- No artificial noisemakers will be allowed
- Spectators will be prohibited from forming pep lines or tunnels on the pool deck

Playing Rules

o All MHSAA and National Federation rules will be followed

Officials

o Two officials will be assigned for each dual meet (if possible)

Make-Up Dates

- o Postponed meets will be made up on the next available date as determined by participating school ADs & coaches
- o Division meets will take precedence over non-division meets

Media

- o Bona fide media shall be provided access to the facility and press areas
- o Photography restrictions will be established by the host school consistent with similar indoor events

Results

- Host school will report results to SEC Standings (https://www.secstandings.com/report-a-score/text-a-score)
- o Schools will report results to swimcloud.com or the designee within 48 hours

Host School Expectations

- Provide equipment and personnel necessary to run the meet
- o Have water and ice for both teams (if possible)
- o Locker room facilities for the visiting team
- Certified athletic trainer or doctor (if possible)
- Host school trainers will tape the visiting team (if asked), and as a courtesy, the visiting team should bring taping supplies

Weather Policies & Suspensions

- o If a meet is to be canceled in advance due to weather and/or pool conditions, the visiting team shall be notified prior to 2:00 p.m.
- o Once a meet begins, the decision to suspend lies with officials; resumption of play will be determined by host school management
- o If play cannot continue after suspension, the meet will resume from point of suspension
