- 10) Is this a structured program or more relaxed/informal program? How is that reflected in the policies and other areas?

- 11) What are the program's policies regarding homework? What happens if a student does not complete assigned homework?

- 12) What are the expectations for behavior?

- 13) What are the policies for arriving and picking students up on time?
