COLEUS

CARE GUIDE

Coleus are colorful, easy to grow,
and perfect for brightening any space!

Full color. Easy care. Happy plant!



LIGHT

Bright, indirect light is best.
Can handle some direct sun
(morning is ideal).
Too much shade =
dull colors & leggy growth.



WATER

Keep soil slightly moist.
Water when top inch
feels dry.
Don't let it fully dry out.
Droopy leaves =
thirsty plant.



SOIL

Use well-draining
potting soil.
Regular indoor mix
works great.
Add perlite for
better drainage.



TEMPERATURE

Loves warmth!
Keep above 60°F.
Not frost-tolerant—
bring inside
if it gets cold.



PRUNING (IMPORTANT!)

Pinch the top regularly.
This keeps it
full and bushy.
Remove flowers to
encourage leaf growth.



PROPAGATION (EASY WIN!)

Cut a stem below a node.
Place in water.
Roots grow in about
1–2 weeks.
Plant once roots are
a few inches long.



! COMMON ISSUES



Yellow leaves
= overwatering



Faded colors
= not enough light



Leggy growth
= needs pruning
+ more light
