The traveling Upper Valley E-Bike Lending Library is coming to Hanover June 27 to July 9 with events at Storrs Pond, on the Green after the July 4 Parade, downtown at the Parking Garage, and at 4 locations on the Dartmouth campus! Take advantage of these many opportunities to see how an e-bike can make your local travel less costly, less polluting, more healthy and fun!

The Library is FREE and includes 4 different e-bike models. Bring your own helmet or borrow one of ours. There are no residency requirements. Options are:
