- We have had a few bus route cancellations due to staffing shortages. **To get updates on bus route cancellations, please join our REMIND messaging system by texting the number 81010 with the message “@hvr school” Please remember if a bus route is canceled it will be for both the AM/PM.**
 - **Please discuss bus behavior with your child. We are suspending many student bus privileges due to misbehavior. The expectation is they stay seated, keep their hands to themselves, don't throw objects inside the bus or out the windows, listen to the bus driver, and use appropriate language. The safety of our students is imperative and we will not tolerate students that cannot meet the expectation of riding the bus appropriately.**
- The transportation department is using “Letters” instead of bus numbers. The letters are on the bus route schedule link found in this update as well as the Taylor School Districts website.
 - We have had to address many behavioral issues on our buses the first week of school. Students that cannot behave on the bus will unfortunately lose bus privileges.
