



A few Helpful Hints for the first two weeks

- Remember to pin your child's name tag to his/her shirt. Name tags should be worn for the first 2 weeks of school. This will help the teachers who have the kiddos for Art, Music, Gym, Computers, and Creative Movement, as they have lots of new names and faces to learn.
- We will have snack time each day in the afternoon. If your child brings his/her lunch, please pack an afternoon snack and drink in a separate baggie. Otherwise, kids tend to eat their snack for lunch.
- If your child is ordering lunch please let me know. In the past, I've had too many kiddos think that their snack is their lunch. Often times, they will bring a snack in a lunch bag and not sign up for hot lunch. If you put a note in your child's folder, I can make sure they are all set.

- Please send in a change of clothes for your child to keep in his/her locker. At this age, some kids have accidents or

want to change if they spill something on their clothing. An extra set of clothes really saves the day!

- Please send in a note anytime your child has a change in transportation home from school. I don't always have a chance to check my email or text messages, so a note is the best route. The note should be placed in your child's take home folder. If you don't know about the schedule change until later in the day, please call the office.
- School supplies may be sent in anytime. If your child rides the bus, you may send in a few items a day. I know that too much weight in the backpack is tricky for little ones. I have extra supplies at school, and we will be using those supplies for the first week. I have individual boxes of crayons for each kiddo to start off the school year.
- I know in the summer, kids love to wear flip flops. I love them too! However they are not the easiest for sitting on the carpet with, or playing on the playground. Tennis shoes or shoes with a back work the best. I LOVE VELCRO shoes as they are so easy for kids to put on!
- Please empty your child's take home folder each day, and send it back. I look at the folders each morning for notes, and I send home the work your child completes.
