



Question 1) What days and time will my son or daughter have games or practices?

Answer 1) We do not normally know our practice and games schedules until the end of March. Our games and practice schedules depend on the availability of the head coach, our coordination with other neighboring leagues, etc. If you are interested in registering for Tee Ball Baseball or Softball, your child will likely practice for 45 minutes at Center Street School between the hours of 9 AM and 12 PM each Saturday from late March to late June. For all other divisions, plan on one practice per week and one to two games per week. Anything during the week will be from 5:00 PM until dusk. Most weekend games or practices are for 1-2 hours on Saturdays anytime between 9 AM and 8 PM or Sundays anytime between the hours of 1 PM and 8 PM.

Question 2) What are the benefits of registering for the Albertson-Herricks Little League?

Answer 2)

- a) On the Tee Ball Baseball and Softball Level, you will get a minimum of 10 instructional hours from trained parent volunteers and board members. That comes out to less than \$15 per session. All other Divisions play approximately ten games and will have at least ten practices. That comes out to less than \$10 per session.
- b) We have an AHLL parade day from Searingtown School to Caemmerer Park usually in mid to late April. Participation is free for all registered players.
- c) We have an AHLL picture day where you will have the opportunity to purchase individual and team pictures. This is usually at the end of April.
- d) We have a partnership with the New York Mets professional baseball team where the Mets allow us an AHLL night at Citi Field. This past spring, we had it on Friday, June 1st against the Arizona Diamondbacks. On this evening, all players who had parents in attendance were able to go on the actual field before the game for a parade. The AHLL picked the cost of all participating players. Any tickets purchased by parents cost approximately \$25.

- e) We had our 2024 trophy day on June 22 at Caemmerer Park. All players had free ice cream, drinks and a hot dog. They also were able to use a dunk tank and win prizes at several Baseball and Softball skill stations. Basic attendance is totally free for all families. We also had free items donated by our generous sponsors for auction including free 100 level tickets to four different Mets games at Citi Field.. We also provided food for all adults and children thanks to generous donations from AHLL sponsors Dominick's Italian Deli, Ceriello Fine Foods, and DaAngelo's Pizzeria.
