

## **How to Add RUSD Calendar Subscriptions to Your Calendar App**

**First, obtain the URL for the calendar you wish to add.**

[RUSD District Calendar](#) (district-wide events that impact all three schools)

[Reed School Calendar](#) (school-specific events)

[Bel Aire Calendar](#) (school-specific events)

[Del Mar Calendar](#) (school-specific events)

1. Select the option for **Upcoming Events**.
2. At the top corner of the calendar, click the grey square **RSS** button.
3. In the window that pops up, hover over the **ICAL** button for the calendar you wish to add.
  - a. Select **Standard URL** for Apple/iPhone calendars.
  - b. Select **Google URL** for Google calendars.
  - c. If you select the wrong URL, events will not appear at the correct times.
4. Copy the URL.

**Once you have copied the URL, add it to your Calendar App as a *subscription*** (not an import, as imports won't auto-update when new events are added) by following the specific instructions below:

### **Google Calendar**

1. Open Google Calendar in a browser.
2. On the left, click “**+**” **next to Other Calendars** → **From URL**.
3. Paste the Google URL and click **Add Calendar**.
4. It will appear in your list, and Google will periodically refresh it (at least once every 24 hours).
5. This calendar may not appear in the list on your iPhone - if this is the case, follow instructions below for iPhone.

### **Apple Calendar (Mac)**

1. Open Calendar.
2. Go to **File** → **New Calendar Subscription**.
3. Paste the Standard URL.
4. Set the refresh frequency (e.g., every hour or every day).

### **Apple Calendar (iPhone)**

1. Open Calendar.
2. Click **Calendars** → **Add Calendar** → **Add Subscription Calendar**.
3. Paste the Standard URL and click **Subscribe**.

### **Outlook (Desktop or Web)**

- **Outlook Desktop:**
  1. Go to **File** → **Account Settings** → **Internet Calendars** → **New**.
  2. Paste the URL.
- **Outlook Web:**
  1. Go to **Add Calendar** → **Subscribe from Web**.
  2. Paste the URL.

### **Troubleshooting**

- Events showing the wrong time?
  - Make sure the correct URL was chosen from the RUSD website (Google or Standard)
- New events not downloading?
  - Make sure the URL was added as a subscription (not an import) following the specific instructions above
- Events showing on computer calendar but not on iPhone calendar?
  - Add the URL to your iPhone using the iPhone instructions above
