Students select courses online in Aeries portal. Review course profiles to make accurate selections. <u>After Jan 31</u> students make course changes by contacting their counselor directly. Deadline to make any course change for the 2025-2026 school year.

Course Selection Guidelines:

- ☐ Please carefully consider all course requests, as they determine what classes will be offered and staffing for the school year. Review the Course Selection materials for your grade level and course descriptions to make thoughtful, informed choices.
- ☐ Students are requesting classes only, not teachers or periods. No schedule changes will be made to accommodate any off-campus, extracurricular, or athletic activities.
- ☐ Courses may be canceled due to insufficient enrollment or staffing restrictions.
- ☐ SDUHSD Board Policy sets a two-week limit at the beginning of each semester to add or drop a class without it reflecting on the transcript. Level changes (ex. from honors) may be requested during this period only if there is space available.
- ☐ Students must take a minimum of (3) classes per day. Students are not required to take (4) classes per day, and have the option to select an unscheduled period.* If an unscheduled period is selected, no class or teacher will be assigned and no attendance is taken.
- ☐ The only way to indicate that a student is requesting not to have a class during a specific period or term is to request an unscheduled period. No schedule changes will be made to change periods or terms for already scheduled classes.
- ☐ Students will be able to view their class schedules in the Aeries Portal in August. Required schedule changes will be made for students who failed a course or completed a pre-approved off-campus summer class.
- ☐ Eligible students may apply for Independent Study Physical Education* (ISPE) at sduhsd.net. All students who apply for ISPE must have completed the required Health curriculum and Grade 10-12 students must have taken the CA fitness test before they will be approved for ISPE. **If a student is approved, the student will not be assigned to a class or teacher that period and no attendance will be taken.**
- ☐ 12th-grade students may be given preference in elective classes and courses required for graduation.
- ☐ 30 credits maximum from approved concurrent off-campus coursework can be applied toward graduation requirements and courses will be added to a student's transcript **only** if the course is pre-approved before the student enrolls in the course.

Course Selection FAQs

When and where do I turn in the Course Selection Contract	You turn in the <u>signed</u> course selection contract to your counselor when your entire 2nd period class goes to the counseling office sometime in February or March. Please ask your 2nd period teacher when your class goes to the counseling office.
Why don't I see a class on my course selection contract?	Not all courses are offered for each grade level. Please review the courses on your grade-level specific course selection contract.
Can I change my course selection after selecting them in Aeries?	Yes, every student meets with their counselor in Feb/March and your counselor can make changes at that time. Please contact your counselor to make changes to your courses in AERIES no later than Mon. March 17 at 3:30pm.
Do I have to take a language other than English?	A language other than English is not a SDUHSD graduation requirement but is required to meet college admission requirements. The UC's and CSU's require that students take 2 years.
I will need to repeat a course but I do not see the course on the course selection form?	If you need to repeat a class, write the name of the class on your course selection form and your counselor will add it to your AERIES course list when you meet with them during 2nd period course registration meeting.
