4. What is one main reason (which we take for granted) that allows us to do business on the other side of the world and not rely on the nation we are *in*? Does this mean geographical borders are important?...

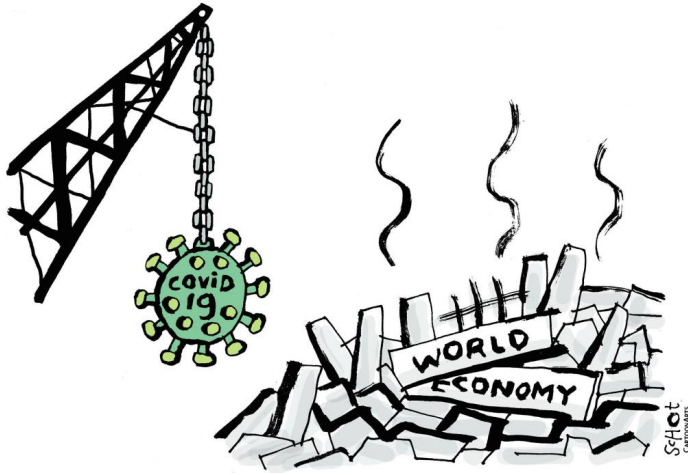
5. What is a tariff? Yes...I know we know this...But I want you to know!
