

Aliso Niguel High School: Guest Contract

All Guest Contracts must be turned in to Activities Director's office for approval, PRIOR to purchasing tickets.

PLEASE PRINT LEGIBLY OR YOUR CONTRACT WILL NOT BE PROCESSED.

- Read and abide by all rules in contract (see below)
- Signature of approval by an administrator from the guest's high school, **ALONG WITH THE BUSINESS CARD OF THE ADMINISTRATOR SIGNING.**
- <u>Attach</u> a CLEAR photocopy of the guest's picture ID (high school ID or driver's license for <u>non</u>-high school students).
- Parent signatures of ANHS student and guest (if applicable.)
- Guest contracts will not be accepted after April 30th at 3:30pm. Tickets must be purchased in person by closing time at the kiosk (3:30pm) on Thursday, May 1st, 2025. Limited tickets may be available on Friday, May 2nd for purchase until 3:30pm, with no ASB discounts.

All signatures will be verified, and any forgery will result in not being able to attend the dance. Forgery will also result in payment, no refund will be given. Forgery may also result in loss of admittance and no refund for current Aliso Niguel students.

- No refunds will be issued. Tickets may not be transferred from any student to another without expressed written
 permission from both the parent of the student and from an assistant principal. To transfer the ticket, a refund is
 issued to the first ticket holder and then it is re-sold to the second ticket holder. Money does not pass from one
 ticket holder to another.

- The 2025 Prom will be held on Saturday, May 3rd, 2025 at The Observatory OC, 3503 S Harbor Blvd, Santa Ana, CA 92704. The dance begins at 7:30 p.m. and ends at 10:30 p.m. NO STUDENTS WILL BE ADMITTED AFTER 8:30 P.M. UNLESS PRIOR ARRANGEMENTS HAVE BEEN MADE WITH THE ACTIVITIES DIRECTOR, Mrs. Ross. Parents will be notified if their child does not check in and purchased a ticket.
- 2. Students may not leave the dance before 9:30 p.m. Those who leave at 9:30 p.m. or after will not be readmitted.
- 3. Students must be picked up within 15 minutes of the conclusion of all dances. Students being left at the venue longer than 15 minutes past the conclusion of the dance will not be allowed to attend their next formal dance.
- 4. District policy states that all guests must be UNDER the age of 20 years and 11 months and middle school students may not attend. Aliso Niguel students and their guests must complete the guest contract and are required to abide by all ANHS & CUSD rules, and the terms of the contract. Anyone exhibiting disruptive behavior will be removed from the dance, parents will be notified, and no refunds will be given.
- 5. Formal attire is required. Ladies may wear dress slacks and blouses or dresses, and gentlemen must wear dress shirts and dress slacks along with a coat and tie. Beach type sandals, combat boots, shorts, corduroy and jeans are not allowed. CUSD Dress code applies to school dances.
- 6. According to Board Policy 5144.1, "Students are to be recommended by the school principal for expulsion if they are found: Possessing, using, or being under the influence of any controlled substance, alcoholic beverage, or intoxicant of any kind." Students who are in violation of this policy will be suspended and recommended for expulsion. The sheriff will be notified, and the parents will be called to escort their child home. A breathalyzer may be used to test students suspected to be under the influence of alcohol.
- 7. Students may be checked by private security for illegal or controlled substances prior to entry to the dance area. Any student who refuses to be checked will be denied entry.
- 8. ANY vehicle, including limousines, party buses, can be searched. ALL PASSENGERS WILL BE HELD RESPONSIBLE AND MAY BE GIVEN CONSEQUENCES FOR ANY ILLEGAL SUBSTANCE IN THE VEHICLE.
- 9. All students must present their student ID at the registration table. All guests must present their high school ID or valid picture identification to be admitted to the dance.
- 10. Trading or selling of tickets between students is not allowed.
- 11. Students removed or denied entry will not be given refunds. In these cases, parents will be called.
- 12. Any student who is dancing inappropriately may be removed from the dance and lose privileges to attend future activities and disciplinary actions may be taken.

- 13. Students who violate the terms of this contract are subject to suspension from school and loss of privileges to participate in any co-curricular and extracurricular activities including athletics, senior activities, and possibly commencement exercises. The ANHS student and their parents are responsible for the guest's behavior. If there is a problem with a guest, the Aliso Niguel student will lose the privilege to bring a guest to any future Aliso Niguel dance.
- 14. We will be serving an assortment of desserts, refreshments, water and soft drinks throughout the evening.
- 15. TICKETS MUST BE PURCHASED BY 3:30 p.m. on Thursday, May 1st, 2025. Some tickets may be available for purchase on Friday, May 2nd, with no ASB card discounts available. Please note the pricing structure for this event.
- 16. No refunds will be issued.
