If you are still missing certain expectations please ensure you include them specifically in the summative.


- 1. Start by doing this: Choose ONE theory from the shared document and show how it relates to the study of critical cultural issues.
 - a. Explain the theory and show which parts of it you will relate to your topic.
 - b. Put the theory at the beginning of your project and refer to it throughout the project.
- 2. Unit 2: Show me how the <u>concept of culture</u> relates to whether or not we should continue to encourage people to have culture.
 - a. Be sure to refer to examples of cultural elements and functions
 - b. Then EXPLAIN how cultures are transmitted, preserved and transformed. Draw your own conclusions about whether this is good or not.
 - c. Relate your examples back to your theory
- 3. Unit 3: Show me that you understand how <u>cultural expression</u> relates to whether or not we should continue to encourage people to have culture.
 - a. Choose specific examples of art/philosophy/religion and explain HOW and WHY they affect culture.
 - b. Is this positive/negative/both? Why?
 - c. Relate your examples back to your theory
- 4. Unit 4: Show me that you understand how <u>critical cultural issues</u> relate to whether or not we should continue to encourage people to have culture.
 - a. Choose specific examples of power relations and explain HOW and WHY they affect culture.
 - b. Do cultural policies or issues affect us positively or negatively?
 - c. Relate your examples back to your theory
