About Pi Day at Math N' More

Pi Day is a high-energy, sports-themed community celebration designed to make math accessible, fun, and meaningful for families in underserved communities. The event blends hands-on learning, friendly competition, and real-world application to help scholars build confidence and excitement around math and STEAM.

Each year, Pi Day brings together hundreds of families, educators, and community partners for an afternoon of interactive learning, games, and celebration.

What We Are Looking For

We are seeking **engaging, hands-on STEAM and STEM activity vendors** who can facilitate interactive experiences for children and families. Activities should be:

- Hands-on and age-appropriate
- Engaging, fun, and visually appealing
- Designed for quick participation in a festival-style setting
- Aligned to STEAM or STEM concepts, especially math, science, engineering, technology, or applied problem-solving

Examples include, but are not limited to:

- Math games and challenges
- Engineering or building activities
- Coding or robotics demonstrations
- Science experiments or simulations
- Aviation, technology, or career-exploration activities
- Sports or movement-based activities connected to math concepts
