The I.S.S.M.A. Solo and Ensemble Contest is an opportunity for students in both middle school and high school bands to grow as musicians by performing as a soloist or in a small ensemble of three or more students.

All students are HIGHLY encouraged to participate in this event as it is both educational and fun. Every event will be performed for a judge and evaluated to receive a Gold, Silver or Bronze medal. The Gold medal is the top honor that a student can earn. <u>This event is the single most beneficial musical activity your student can participate in.</u>

Ensemble Cost: \$10 per person

Solo Cost: \$18

This includes your medal and adjudication results.

Performance times are TBA (morning to early afternoon)

<u>Accompanists:</u> Soloists are highly encouraged to use a piano accompanist. ISSMA feels it is important that soloists use accompanists. The accompanist provides professional support for the student during their performance as well as enriches the experience for the soloist and everyone listening. The value of having an accompanist ensures that students are able to perform with the best possible support and understanding of tempo and style. As students progress, upper level events require the use of an accompanist and students may earn their way to the State Solo and Ensemble Contest.

<u>Finding an Accompanist and Fees:</u> Students are welcome to find their own accompanist or Mr. Day can help you. Fee's are anywhere from \$30-\$80 and are dictated by the difficulty of the music and accompanist.



Tips for success!

It is HIGHLY recommended that everyone take at least one event (Solos are easier logistically) to contest. It is also recommended that you NOT take more than one solo and one ensemble. You can take more with the director's approval. All learning for solo and ensemble contests will be outside of class. Please work with the directors and more experienced musicians.

Solos: Practice your solo daily until contest day.

Ensembles: As a group, practice at least once a week until contest day. Practice your individual part daily. One person will be the leader of the group and organize everyone's schedule to make sure practices happen weekly. The ensemble will be named after the leader of the group. *All members of an ensemble must be in the same instrument family (Brass, Woodwinds, or Percussion).*
