Environmental Science Scholarship
Due Thursday, April 23, 2026

Purpose: Provided annually by Heather Carpenter, a former EHS graduate (class of 1998), this scholarship promotes environmental science and its impact on our local community.

Award Amount- The scholarship amount available is \$1,000 and may be divided if more than one student is chosen to receive the award.

Eligibility- This scholarship is open to all graduating EHS students who want to apply.

Requirements: The scholarship requires students to 1) complete an essay and 2) submit one letter of recommendation. Students must attend college classes in the fall of 2026 to receive the scholarship.

The essay must be typed, between 500 and 1,000 words, and double-spaced. Essays must address the following questions:

Essay Prompt Questions- What is your local community's most challenging environmental issue? What can you do to fix this challenging issue?

Please staple this cover page to the essay and letter of recommendation, and submit the entire application by 3:45 p.m. to the College and Career Center by April 23rd, 2026.
