

Merit Badge Away Day FAQ

You were at an Austin FC Away Day game and some lovely person handed you a card promising you a free patch. Now what?

How do I get my patch?

Send the card itself, along with a self-addressed, stamped-envelope to:

Austin TX 78718

Once received, the Merit Badge team will send you out a patch within 6-8 weeks.

Is there a cost for the patch?

Nope! Patches are provided for free thanks to [Odd Colored Sheep](#) and Los Verdes to thank you for traveling to support our boys. We do ask that you pay shipping via a self-addressed, stamped-envelopes though.

Can I redeem multiple patches, either from the same or multiple trips with a single self-addressed, stamped-envelope?

Yes, typically you can ship up to two patches with one stamp. If you're redeeming more than that, we recommend putting on additional postage.

I went to the game, but no one gave me a card. Can I still get a patch?

Sorry about that! Absolutely you can still get one. Send us an email at merithub@atxcutcrew.com along with some proof of your travels, like a photo of you at the game, a copy of your ticket, etc. and we'll get you sorted.

Why don't you just give out patches at the game?

Traveling is stressful, so it's easy to lose a patch at the game or during the festivities. Rather than risk it, we'll just send you one once you're home. It also helps us keep this a free service by making sure we don't accidentally make too many patches.
