STOCKING NEW/ DNR UPDATES

This fall we had a couple surprises. The WIDNR is now allowing Wisconsin Strain fish to be stocked into Shawano again. We were able to put 875 fish into the system. The total cost of these fish was \$12,000, with the generous donations from Matt's Memorial Musky Tournament (\$5,000), Dave's Musky Club (\$2,000), and \$5,000 from the club we were able to make it happen. We can't thank these two clubs enough for the generous donations.

Next, we just found out that no Great Lakes Strain fish were stocked this year throughout the entire state. Both hatcheries had a fish die off due to an unknown virus. That is about all we know at this time but if they continue to have issues with the hatchery it will probably allow for more fish to be stocked next year.

Lastly, Shawano's fish Biologist Aaron O'Connell has stepped down. There were a couple things in the works with Aaron, so we are hoping to still get these accomplished. One was getting Shawano off every other year stocking and moving it to every year stocking. We are unsure at this time who will be taking over for him but hope to have as great of working relationship with the next biologist as we did him and get these things accomplished. At this time, we are unsure if they will be looking to do the movement study as he had but we are still hopeful.

BANQUET

Sorry, there was no banquet this fall. With the transition it did not allow enough time. It was decided at the last meeting that spring would be the best. We are still getting the exact date and location figured out but as soon as it is known we will get the mailers out. The mailers will be out with plenty of time for people to get them in.
