

Come fall and winter season, it is vital that your heater is working appropriately and producing enough heat to warm your house. If your heater stops producing heat or is blowing cool air, there are a variety of possible offenders, beginning with your thermostat. Learn the best ways to fix the issue prior to you freeze!

What To Do

For starters, once a year, vacuum out the location around the heater's blower. If possible, also move out the fan system, clean each fan blade with a toothbrush, and then vacuum with a brush attachment on a vacuum. While you're at it, try to find oil ports on the motor, normally situated near the motor shaft.

Apply 2 to 3 drops of non-detergent motor oil into each port (you may have to eliminate a cover plate to do this)if the motor has these. Most modern motors do not need lubrication, do lubricate motors with oil ports when a year. For more about maintenance, see Maintenance Checklist for Central Heating Systems.
