



Worship Leader...What A Privilege!

Thank you for offering to audition for I Praise Band. I am so excited to meet all of you. God the Holy Spirit is calling(guiding, directing, writing it on your heart) YOU to lead worship of our Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ. That is exciting and awe-inspiring, as well as a great responsibility. Read over the following statements, read the bible verses that accompany the statements, and pray for God's wisdom, strength, and peace as you consider becoming a worship leader:

1. You live to worship God Alone (Luke 4:8)
2. Your everyday life reflects Scripture's definition of love. (1 Corinthians 13:4-8)
3. You know and use the 3 beautiful words often, "I Forgive You". (Ephesians 4:32)
4. Your behavior reflects Jesus; in the classroom, in the car, with your friends, in your interaction with your parents, in your choices outside of school, etc. You have been called by the Holy Spirit to present yourself as a living sacrifice. (Ephesians 5:1 and Romans 12: 1-2)
5. You are not afraid. (Joshua 1:9)
6. You do not deceive yourself. You have fallen short of the Glory of God and you need the Savior. (Romans 3:23-24)
7. Your demeanor on stage shows excitement and/or awe of Jesus' sacrifice for you, even at 6:30 in the morning (1 Corinthians 10:31)
8. The reaction of the audience does not affect your calling as a worship leader. If the audience is dead silent, you still have your calling. If the audience makes faces at you, you still have your calling. If the audience wildly applauds, you still have your calling. Your audience is ONE! When Jesus looks at your heart, let Him see your desire for Him. (1 Corinthians 10:31)
9. You go to Jesus daily in prayer (use JOY if you're not sure how to pray): (1 Thessalonians 5:16-22)
 - J is for Jesus. Forgiveness, Thankfulness, Awe,
 - O is for Others. Forgiveness, intercession(illness, confused, lost, etc)
 - Y is for You. Your needs(and you have lots!); Strength, Guidance, Peace, Comfort, Wisdom
10. You are surrounded by a cloud of witnesses (Hebrews 12:1). You choose to be with other Christians on a regular basis (go to church). If you don't have a church home, I or other members of the Praise Band can offer suggestions.

Remember, being a worship leader(i.e. "In praise band") is a servant's position. You are called to lift others up through your music.
