It was determined that a vote to automatically declare all current members signatory to the Libertas Convention was a violation of sovereignty. All member nations not currently signatory will be reminded to do so.

3. Explain how proposing legislation will work

If someone thinks new legislation needs to be written, they can use the template provided to write it or use their own if they wish.

When the first draft is completed, it will be submitted to the Mediator General, who will post it publicly for all member nations to read and digest it, then the Mediator General will propose it at the next assembly session.

During this assembly session, it will be discussed, and any member can put forth a motion for it to be voted upon or tabled again for the next assembly session.

This cycle will continue until the members successfully vote to abandon or enact the proposal during an assembly session.

This proposal was well-received by those present. Nothing to add.

4. Propose the Revitalized Membership Act

A motion to open voting on this act passed and the vote was opened. Warmedic of NeoUK may be working on a set of procedures for the assembly.

David Augustus of Monmark:

"I have taken the suggestion of @Liam - Kingdom of Atiera and will start with positives, they are very serious, with good legit land claims, and are very open in their policies. I think they need to improve by finishing their constitution and beginning to further develop their economy. They were founded last year and have been through a dual monarchy called the Begonian Circonian Empire."

Tyler M. of the Free Nation of New Athens:

"My remarks: They look very serious and have good land claims like Emperor-Monmark said. They are also more developed in terms of their culture and political system than a lot of nations that I've seen. Their constitution not being fully developed is both a con and a pro, because aiding nations in constitution writing has been a service we've been providing recently. Another con that could also be a pro is that they are a part of a lot of unions and groups, but that can call into question how active they might be here. Overall, I'd vote for them. Their culture and seriousness are exemplary compared to a lot of nations these days."
