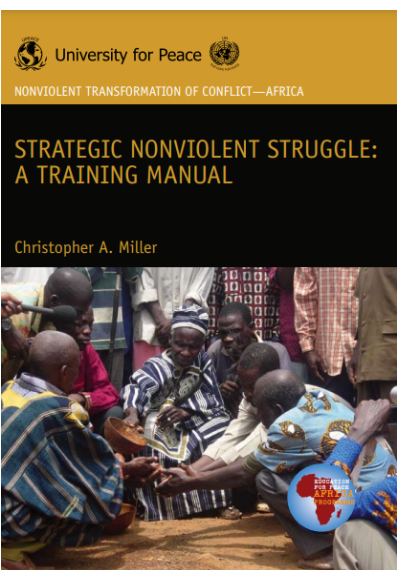
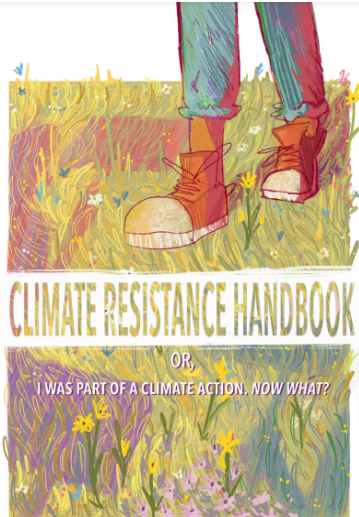

And what is needed to optimise the capacity of those involved?” Twenty respondents from trade unions, civil society, academia and political parties in the Philippines and South Africa were interviewed, along with labour support organisations in the Global North.
