Heat advisory:

We've been scoping out the weather and as of right now it looks like we'll have some temperatures in the 90s in Tacoma until 7/9 and then hopefully we'll see things cool down into the 80's during our programming. **There isn't A/C on campus.** So, make sure to bring water, hats, sunblock, and other items that will help you stay cool and hydrated, and feel free to dress for the weather. We will have a couple outdoor activities, including a catered dinner on 7/10.

If you're lodging on campus we highly recommend bringing a fan to help your room stay cooler if you have one. If you can bring some extra fans in case your dorm neighbor isn't able to bring one, that would be splendid.

When I get to campus, where do I park and how do I check in?

Parking — Parking is free anywhere on campus (unless stated otherwise) and there is also parking in nearby neighborhoods as well. Our map shows a number of different parking areas.

Checking In — Our check-in table is in the lobby of *Trimble Hall*. When you check in you'll get a welcome packet and lanyard. **To eat any of the conference meals (beginning with**

breakfast on July 10) you must be checked in and have a meal badge. If you booked lodging with us you'll get your room info when you check in. Here's a list of times the registration table will be open:

- Tuesday July 9, 1:00pm 7:00pm
 - Arriving after 7pm on July 9? You'll need to call campus security to get your room key and then check in with Eric at the registration table at 8am. Campus security phone # is 253-879-3311.
- Wednesday July 10, 8:00am 5:00pm

 Arriving after 5pm on July 10? Please text Eric Steen well in advance to let him know and then call when you arrive at 503-502-3967
- Thursday July 11, 8:00am 3:00pm

Are meals provided?

During the following times, meals are provided. You must be checked in (see above) to receive a meal badge:

- July 10 Breakfast, lunch, and a catered dinner
- July 11 Breakfast, lunch, and dinner
- July 12 Catered breakfast

Coffee will be available in Trimble Hall Foyer from 6:00am - 5:00pm on July 10, 11, and the morning of July 12.

Code of Conduct

Every attendee has agreed to follow our <u>Code Of Conduct</u>. Please familiarize yourself with it, check out the section on reporting, and know these details are also available in our print program.

Checking out - Key Return and Food Badge Return:

There are fines for lost keys and unreturned meal cards so please make sure to return yours before leaving. Return options are:

- 1. Our key/card return box at the registration table in Trimble Hall Foyer, or
- 2. We'll collect keys during Friday's breakfast.
- 3. Unreturned cards and keys will result in \$35 fines per incident to the attendee

I'm lodging on campus, what is my room number?

When you check-in, you will receive your room information and keys.

I'm lodging on campus, what should I bring?

- Lodging on campus?
 - What's provided If you're lodging on campus know that all beds come with a blanket, sheets, pillow, and a towel.
 - Everything else you will need to provide, including soap, shampoo, etc.
 - Bring a fan If it looks like we'll have a heat wave (and it does look like it could be hot), bring some fans as buildings on campus do not have air conditioning and the university cannot provide extra fans.

- o Extra blanket If you run cold, consider bringing an extra blanket with you
- Bring your own cup! Help us reduce waste by bringing your own mug/cup to Land Camp. You can use this in the morning when you're drinking coffee, or in the evening when at our evening hangouts. Thanks in advance!
- Apartment Suites have a small shared kitchenette. In the event that you want to cook food in the kitchen, you will need to bring your own pots/pans/utensils.

July 12 check out

- All guests must vacate their rooms by 10:00am on July 12
- We will have a room key and meal card drop off table in the Trimble Hall Foyer. There are fees for unreturned keys/cards.
- The University may not keep left-behind items. Don't forget your special pillows, fans, toothbrushes, etc!


Smoking
