Justice for Shukri Abdi 12 year old, Shukri, drowned in the River Irwell in Manchester, UK. Shukri could not swim and had recently moved to the UK from Somalia. Greater Manchester Police treated her death as a "tragic accident" and believed that she had jumped into the water to "cool down". Justice for Kendrick Johnson Kendrick was only 17 years old when his body was discovered rolled up in a gym mat in his school. The police deemed it an "accident" and no arrests for his death have been made.	Kendrick Johnson

Justice for Sean Reed Sean was running from police when he was tased in the back by an officer. The officer then shot Sean 14 times in the back. The entire murder was filmed and streamed on Sean's Facebook Live.	Sean Reed
Justice for Emerald Black Emerald lost her unborn child after police officers stomped on her pregnant stomach. The officers left shoe marks on her abdomen. Emerald was forced to spend the night in jail whilst miscarrying.	• Emerald Black

Justice for Darren Rainey Darren was a non-violent offender, jailed for drug possession, who was murdered by prison guards in Miami, Florida. The guards locked him in a boiling hot shower for 2 hours. He suffered from schizophrenia.	Darren Rainey
Justice for Jamel Floyd Jamel died after being pepper sprayed by guards in his cell. Jamel's mother reported that the guards were fully aware of her son's asthma condition.	Jamel Floyd
