

# Course Selection Timeline for 2026-27

Selecting courses for the next year requires student’s active participation. Students have opportunities to prepare, select, review, and change prior to the start of next school year. Take advantage of resources and plan well, especially for college, NCAA, and other opportunities with specific requirements. Meet deadlines. Revisit and revise your graduation plan. Do your research. Ask questions. Schedule a meeting with your school counselor to discuss your post high school plans. Choose meaningful courses that support your academic growth, allow you to maintain and increase rigor in your strength areas, but **most importantly, allow you to have a well-balanced schedule that meets your individual needs.**

Monday, February 23 – Wednesday, April 8	<b>Course Selections Entered in Infinite Campus</b> Counselors meet with current students in small groups to review transcripts, update graduation status, and input courses via Infinite Campus. Students must have completed “Golden Ticket” form prior to meeting with their counselor. There will be an opportunity to make changes to initial course selections before schedules are created.
