Queens Sports & Fitness Club is Halifax's premier squash, tennis and racketball venue and has a long history of sporting excellence with the club dating back to 1887.

They have 8 tennis courts, 6 outdoor and 2 indoor all with floodlights, 5 squash courts, with both

departments managed by full time coaching professionals. There is a well-equipped gym, an on-site physiotherapist and a fully licensed bar.

Please note: Although there is parking at the Sports Club, The road leading to the Queens Sports Club is unadopted & has many potholes. The committee suggests sharing uber/taxis to the venue or parking on the main road near to the club to avoid any damage to your vehicle.

AGM & Competition Draw

The AGM will take place at the **Club** at **3:30pm** Friday 4th and play will be as follows:

Friday 4th Start 4pm and finish around 8/9pm.

*Losers of the 1st round will automatically be entered into a **MONRAD system** whereby you play to a final position, which means you may play 3 or 4 times over the weekend, these matches will be best of 3 games*

Saturday 5th Start 10am and conclude around 5/6pm. Quarter Finals & Semi Finals Day

Sunday 6th Start 10am with final play off matches. Finals will commence from 1pm.

A member of the National Committee will be nominated to act as Tournament Referee. The Match organiser and Marker allocation will also be done by members of the National Committee. These committee members will be identified at the draw.

Players may be asked to volunteer their services as markers during the tournament.

Health and Safety

Correct and appropriate clothing /equipment must be worn and be free from defect. The wearing of protective eyewear, although not mandatory, is recommended.

Entertainment

There will be a meal laid on for all players and guests on the Friday night at the Club.

There will be no formal arrangements for the Saturday 5th April: however, Halifax is a historic market town nestled in the South Pennines amidst scenic landscapes and a rich industrial heritage. Worthy of a visit is 'The Piece Hall' which is a Grade I listed building and the sole survivor of the great eighteenth century northern cloth halls. It offers a unique shopping, dining and cultural experience.

The Presentation dinner will be held at The Cedar Court Hotel (**7pm for 7.30pm**) on Sunday night and will include: a three-course meal & wine. A disco with DJ will provide entertainment following the presentation of prizes. A formal seating plan will be arranged.

In keeping with our tradition, the dress code is preferably Black Tie/Lounge Suits/Cocktail Dresses, although this is not mandatory.
