1. **Professional Development from STATE OFFICE MSBOA**
 - d. D10 Eboard will discuss this at the Spring Meeting to schedule for the 23-24 school year.
 - i. State Level MSBOA will provide outreach to the Membership in the form of meaningful professional development by matching the experience and expertise of our Emeritus/Honorary Members to the needs of the District.
 - ii. This in-service would occur at a central location in the District for no more than 2 hours at a host school. The District would have been previously surveyed as to their current needs. MSBOA would facilitate in matching, contacting, and arranging for a Clinician to do the in-service.
 - iii. The State would pay the clinician's stipend and mileage at \$.50 per mile up to a maximum of 350 miles once per year. The individual Districts would be responsible for any additional costs or additional sessions.
