Video Instructions

You will go through 3 rounds.

Round 1 = You and up to 4 partners at your desks

Round 2

- Divide the room into left, center and right
 - $\circ\quad\text{at max you will be working with 2 other groups of 4}$
- Select 1 representatives from your pod to argue your points to incorporate into the larger section

Round 3

- Select 1 mediator for the class
 - this person will in charge of writing the totals and categories on the board
 - this person is also putting the item to a vote after debate
- Select 2 people from each of the larger groups to stand up and represent your sections and argue your points of what is most important and why it should be on the board.
- Every item on the board must be voted on and accepted by 2/3 of the class that is sitting down.

You earn a point for every item that you were able to successfully argue all the way through. Meaning it was on your paper from the group of 4 and was on the board at the end of the day.
