- Grant application status Austin G.
  - We seem to be well positioned for the year 2 NOFO
  - Early access to the next NOFO coming as quickly as today (July 5<sup>th</sup>)
  - o All applications will be funded
  - o Defining who gets what from the available funds and the profiles of the applicants
  - No additional resources needed for the application development from the applications and plan
- Pisces and longer term EDR Jonah Wisch
  - Pisces program
    - Intern-staffed security operations center
    - Interns are paid
    - Interns sourced from veterans, adult education, higher ed, bootcamps, workforce platforms
    - SOC works with an analyzer deployed at the network boundary of a local gov
  - Workforce development
    - Staff can get initial cyber experience in real environment, then enter workforce
    - Inexpensive for local governments
    - Can place interns or staff directly into local governments
  - Crowdstrike
    - Expanding SOC services to serve local governments crowdstrike implementations after the expiration of the IIJA funding
    - Already working with a CO city to support their crowdstrike implementation
    - Open question about breach warranty carrying over from transitions across SOC services
