Instructions:

This worksheet is intended to guide you through the creation of a "capstone" presentation about what you've learned about AWS and cloud computing. Please continue to use a ChatBot (preferably <u>claude.ai</u>) to help you figure out all the details.

Goal

The goal of this presentation is to share a high-level view of the system that you have created and to give other students a basic understanding of how AWS works and why it is useful. In the process, you should explain your mental model of the system and how you used ChatGPT to fill in the important details. In essence, ask yourself: "what information would I have liked to have had when starting off on the project that wasn't easily provided by Claude.ai".

Note: The goal of this presentation is **not** to show a lot of code and talk through it. It is instead to give others a starting point should they choose to try and mimic what you did.

Specifications

Create a 15-20 minute presentation talking about:

- 1. The system you created within AWS
- 2. How the system compares with a system that runs on your own computer
- 3. Individual pieces of the system that are interesting and what AWS services you used
- Your overall mental model of how developing on AWS works
- Things that you think would be helpful for the end of year project that the class is working on
