

SAMPLE DEBRIEFING SCRIPT / SHEET

Thank you for your participation in this research study. I would like to take a few minutes to tell you about the purpose of this study and to discuss with you exactly what we were trying to assess. For this study it was important that we [withhold some information from you or provide you with incorrect information about some aspects of the study].

As you may know, scientific methods sometimes require that participants in research studies not be given complete information about the research until after they have participated. This is typically because we do not want to influence participant responses in any way. For example, if we tell people what the purpose of the study is and how we predict they will react, then their reactions will not be good indicators of how they would really react in everyday situations. Although we cannot always tell you everything about a study before you participate, however, we do want to tell you everything once the study is complete.

What you should know about this study

Lastly, in order to help us continue to gather strong data we urge you not to discuss this study with other people who are currently participating or who might participate in the future. If they knew the true purpose of the study, it could affect how they behave or answer questions.
