

Academic Highlights

MHS Seniors achieved a 100% graduation rate, the highest in school history!



We gave 788 Advanced Placement exams to 477 students. This is a 100% increase on both exams given and students who participated since 2021. 71% of exams were passed, saving students and families over \$1.6 million in post-secondary tuition.

Mead High had 58 students eligible for 289 concurrent enrollment college credits.

Mead HS once again outperformed the state on the PSAT and SAT for all tests and grade levels.
