Guideline/format for proposal submission

1. Tentative title of the research topic:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Title must give the essence of the research work
2. a. Present state of the art b. Rationale of the proposed research topic:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Not more than five hundred (500) words. What prompted the researcher's interest in the topic under the present situation
3. Objective(s) of the research:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Must include the broad and specific objective(s) If the objective(s) are to be explained in a paragraph, it should be limited to less than three hundred (300) words.
4. Expected result(s)/outcomes of the research:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Briefly explain the expected results/outcomes from the proposed research.
5. Application/scalability:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Briefly explain the possible applications/ opportunity for scalability of the outcome of the proposed research findings
6. Methodology / Approach:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Briefly explain the approach to be taken and methodology to be followed to achieve the expected results/outcomes
7. Study Team [for ITN-BUET Research Project Fund only]	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Clearly mention the name of the person(s) to be engaged in this research with their roles, responsibility, and manning schedule (man-months)
8. Work plan:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Provide a detail work plan mentioning the activities and time schedule in a Gantt chart.
9. Output/Deliverables:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Provide clearly mention the outputs/deliverables with timeline to be submitted.
10. Project Cost: [This part is only applicable for ITN-BUET Research Project Fund]	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Honorarium for the principal investigator Remuneration / fees for employed research associates / assistants / enumerators (where applicable).
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Cost for support services (field workers, labourers, conveyance etc). Cost of consumable materials with break up. Cost of experimental work (if necessary). Cost of report preparation. Any other direct cost.
