Final Project

It's up to you now. Design your own productivity project that will demonstrate the skills, knowledge, and abilities you've gained throughout the semester. This semester we've covered word processing, spreadsheets, and presentations (with a few other things sprinkled in). We have used Microsoft Word, Google Docs, Microsoft Excel, Google Sheets, Microsoft PowerPoint, and Google Slides for productivity software.

Your project will need to include word processing, spreadsheets, and presentation skills. You need to use at least **one Microsoft program** and **one Google program**. There needs to be a **common theme** in the project you create. For example, you might be a writer and use word processing for a story you are writing, presentation software to pitch your book idea to publishers, and a spreadsheet to track readers' input on storylines.

These should be professionally done, well designed, and show your best ability. You will turn in all three parts on Google Classroom. All the information should be in your own words and **NOT PLAGIARIZED**. Any plagiarized projects will receive only partial credit.
