



My Fellow Lions,

Important News -

- Birthdays & Celebrations- If your child is handing out birthday invitations in school, ALL students in the class must be invited. Otherwise, please refrain from sending them to school for distribution. Additionally, MPS Elementary schools have a "no food" policy in accordance to the MPS Student Handbook. This policy keeps students safe due to allergy concerns. We do NOT use food as a part of our class celebrations (birthdays, holidays, end-of-year parties). Please do not send or bring food or candy to your children's classroom for parties or other reasons. For birthdays or other special events, we invite family members in to read a book or do a craft with students as part of the celebration. Please coordinate any visits with the classroom teacher well in advance.
- Electronic Devices & Communication- At the elementary level, no use of a cell phone/smartwatch or other personal communication device will be permitted during school hours. These devices must be turned off or on silent and left in backpacks, stored in a student's locker/cubbie or other place designated by building administration. <u>Use of Cell Phones or Other Personal Communication Devices P-5131.81</u>. Caregivers should not contact

their children via electronic communication during the school day; they should contact the main office. This ensures that we minimize distractions and interruptions during the school day.

- Practice Drill Conducting emergency drills (fire, crisis, lockdown, etc.) is one of the most important ways we enhance our preparedness for students and staff during an emergency. Drills allow us to practice what we need to do when an emergency arises in our school. Orange Avenue School will be conducting a practice lock down drill next week. This will only be a drill and will be conducted in accordance with the School Incident Management Protocols established by the district and in collaboration with our local first responders. Please discuss the importance of our emergency drills with your children. If you have any feedback please reach out to me.
