For the job sample we want you to actually work on a vacancy that we have open. We know that you have no experience in sourcing or recruitment, so don't worry. We want you to do a search on LinkedIn or on any other platform. We leave it up to you how much time you want to invest to figure out how LinkedIn works and any other platform.

Our job sample stage consists out of 4 parts and will take around 3 hours in total.

Preparation (30 minutes)

We will send you the job description we would like you to work on 30 minutes before the intake call. This should give you plenty of time to prepare the questions you might have to get a better understanding of the role.

Part 1 Intake call (max. 20 minutes)

You will have an intake call on the vacancy that we would like you to work on. This call is meant for you to completely understand the role that you will be working on and you can ask any question that you want. You can also ask us any questions you might still have how LinkedIn works.

PART 2 sourcing strategy (1.5 hours)

We would like you to find 5-10 candidates that you think are a match based on the job description and the intake call. Don't focus on quantity but on quality. This assignment is to test your sourcing skills and your process skills.

Part 3 outreach (30 minutes)

We would like you to write a short email (max 500 characters) that will catch the eye of a candidate for whom this role might be of interest. This assignment is to test your writing capabilities and creativity.

You have 2 hours to find relevant candidates and create a short outreach message. We leave it up to you to divide your time and send in all your information on time.

Part 4 Evaluation (max. 30 minutes)

Once you are finished you will have a call to discuss your work. This is to understand your thought process, ask you some additional questions and to get to know you a little bit better as well (and you them!).
