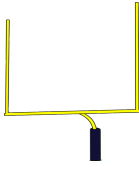

Try this with more than one room.</p>                                                                                    | <p><b>Creative</b></p> <p>Make a book telling your mom why she is the BEST mom EVER! Draw pictures of things you like to do together, include a letter to her or even a poem!</p>                                                                                                                          | <p><b>Math</b></p> <p><b>Race to 100!</b></p> <p>Using a deck of cards, players take a card off the deck and write it down, then on each turn they pick a new card and add it to their total. First player to reach 100 wins! Face cards are 10 and aces 11.</p>                                                                                                                                            |
| <p><b>Reading</b></p> <p>The weather is turning warmer so grab a couple of books and a blanket and head outside for a book “picnic”. Read one book silently, one book out loud...</p>  |  <p>Trace your hand and cut it out. Use it to measure different items in your home to see how many hands tall or wide the item is. Find all sizes of items to measure!</p> | <p><b>Awesome Animals</b></p> <p>Create your own children’s book that shows only animals that you would have in your zoo.
