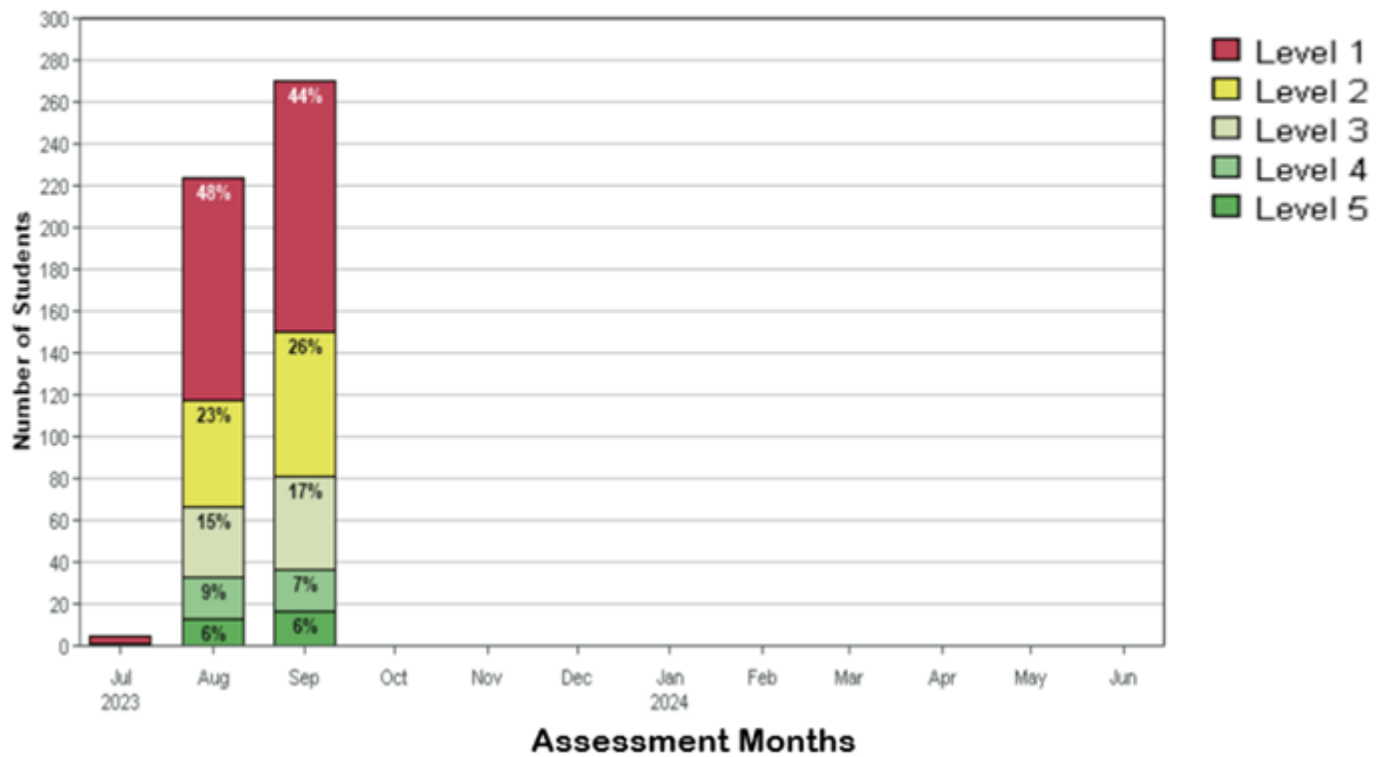

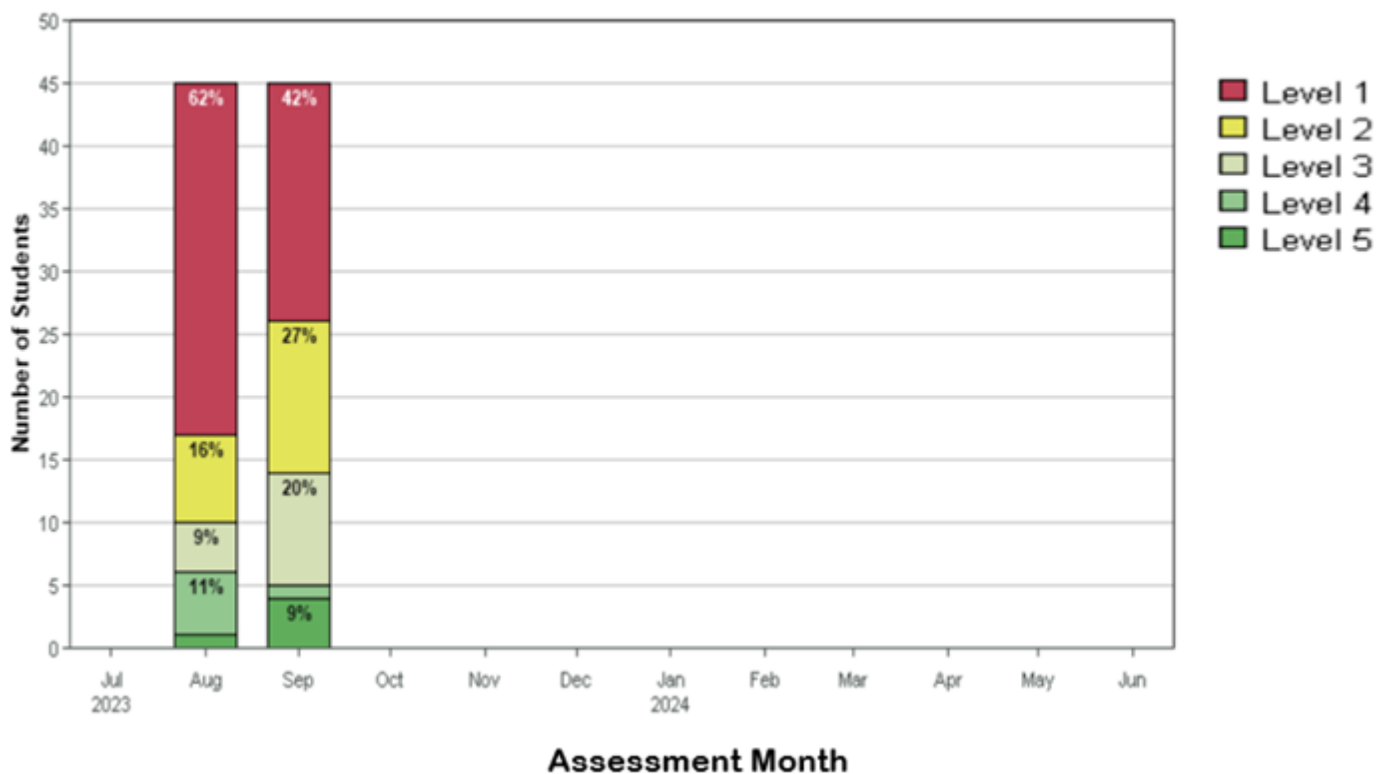

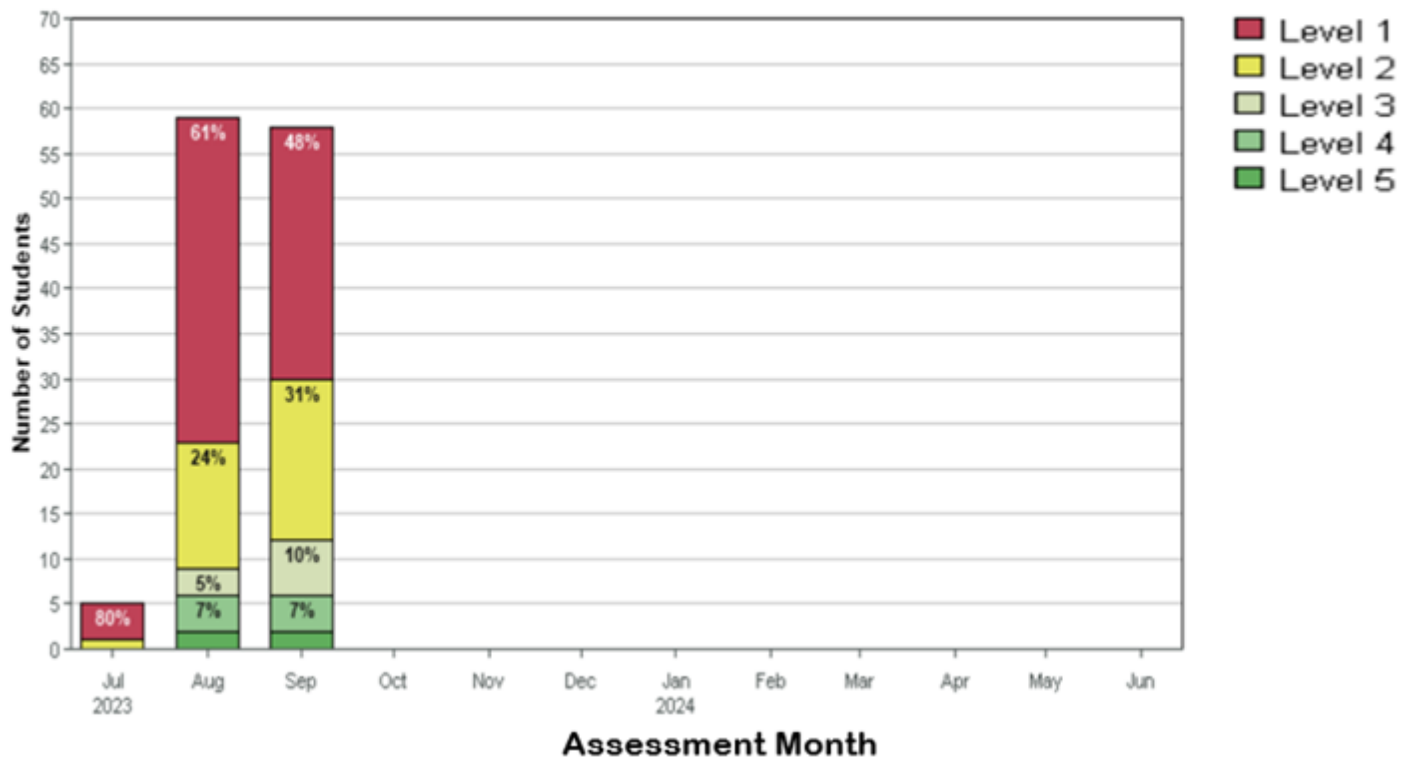
Overall Reading Level Movement-Grades K-4th



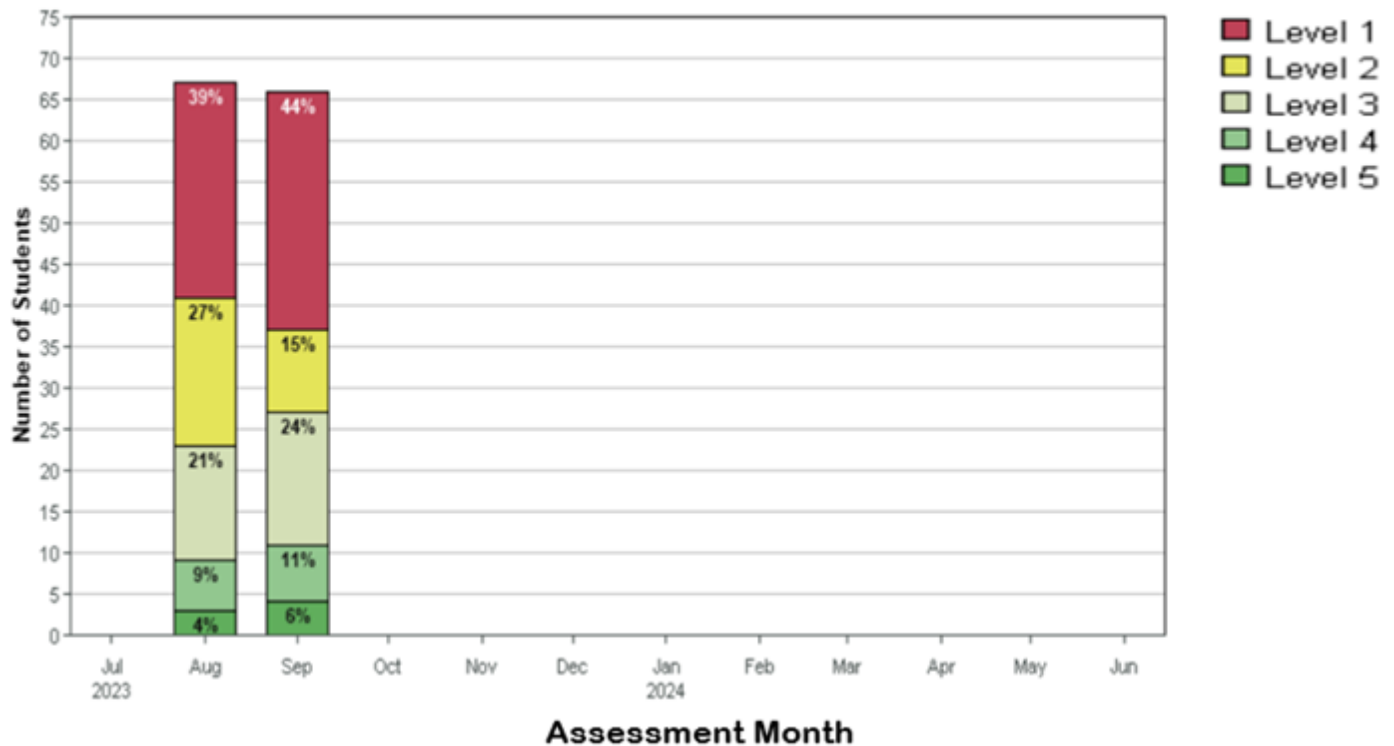
Kindergarten—Overall Reading Level Movement



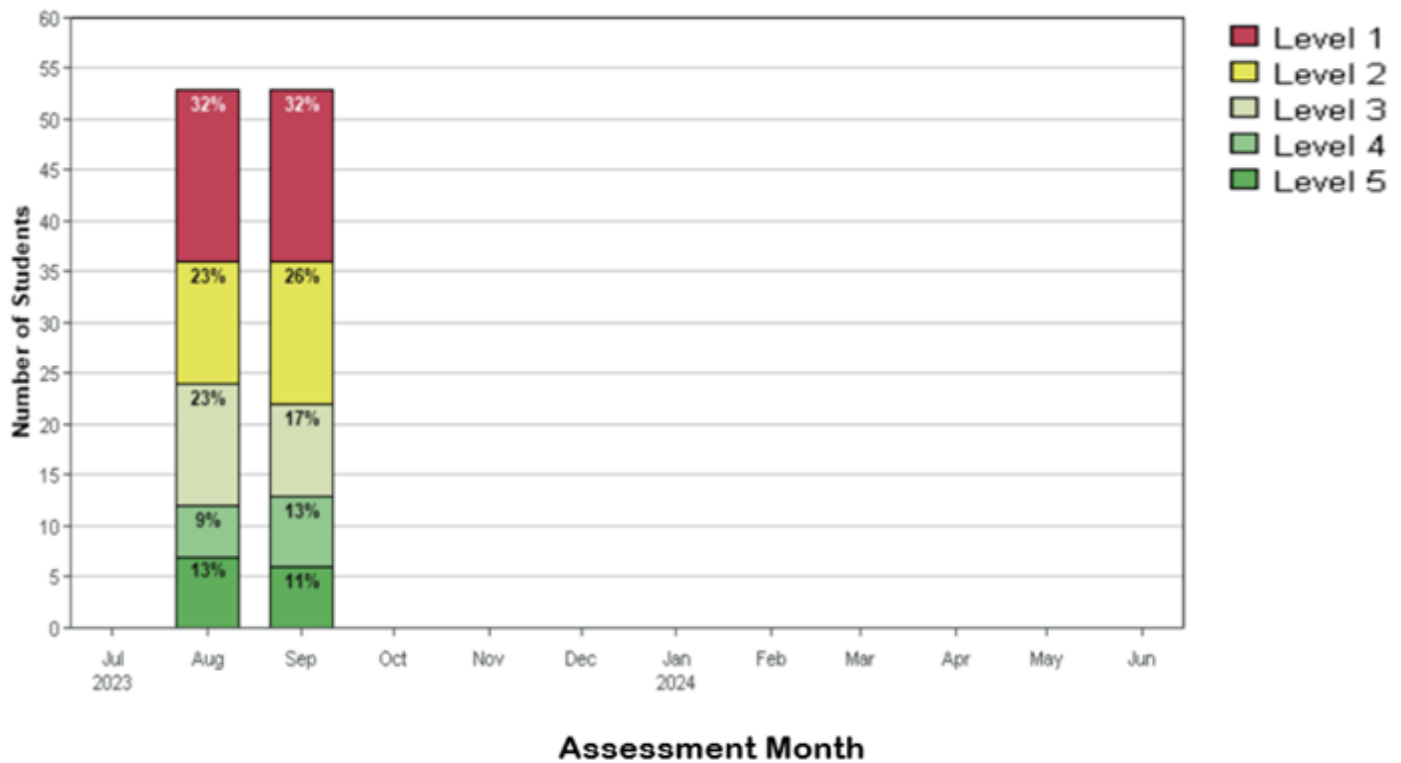
1st Grade—Overall Reading Level Movement



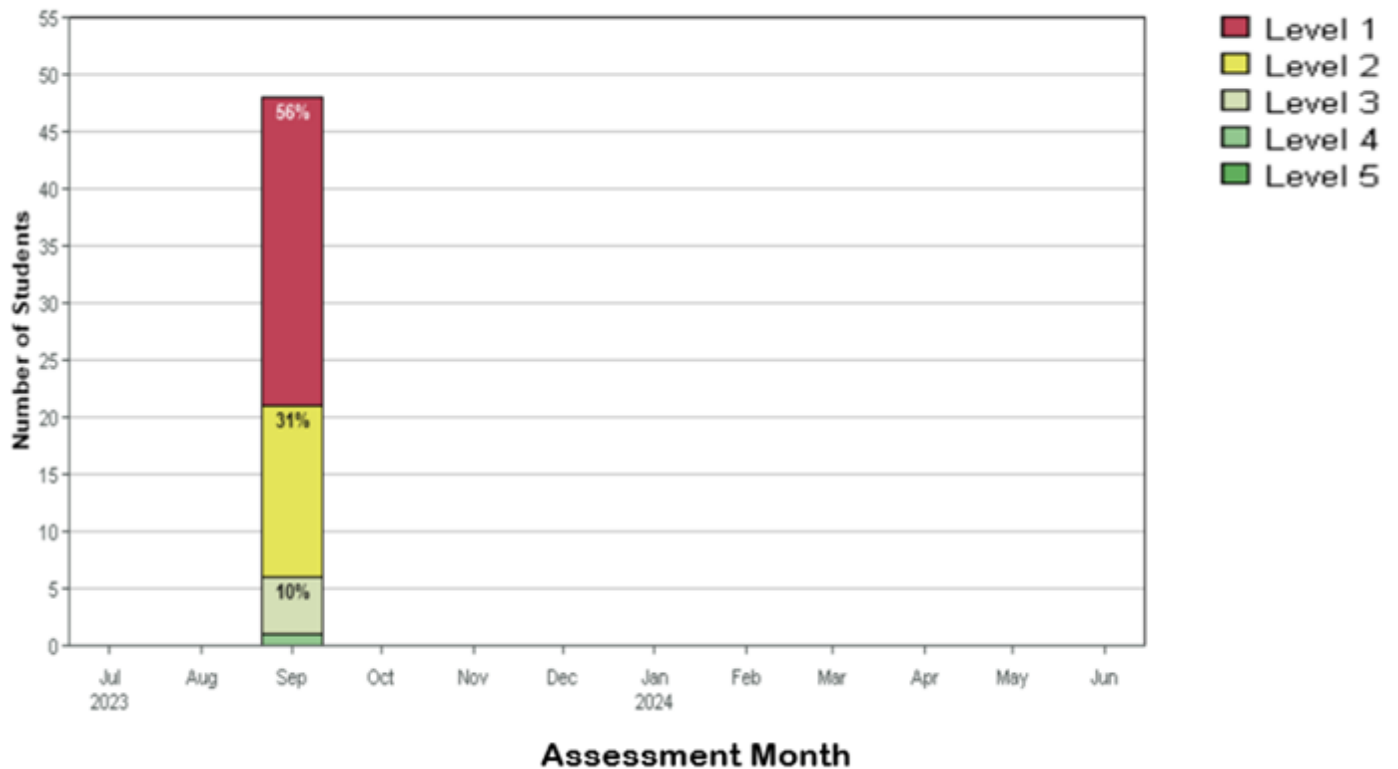
2nd Grade—Overall Reading Level Movement



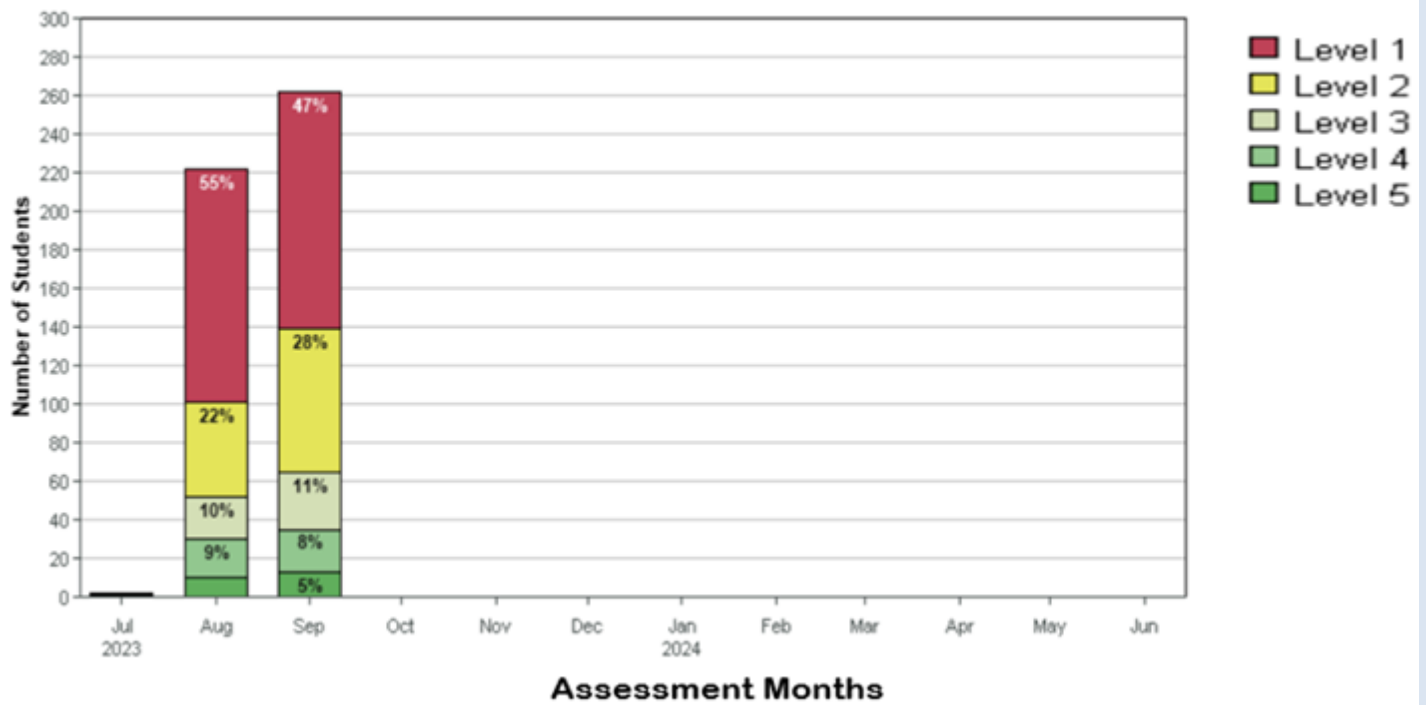
3rd Grade—Overall Reading Level Movement



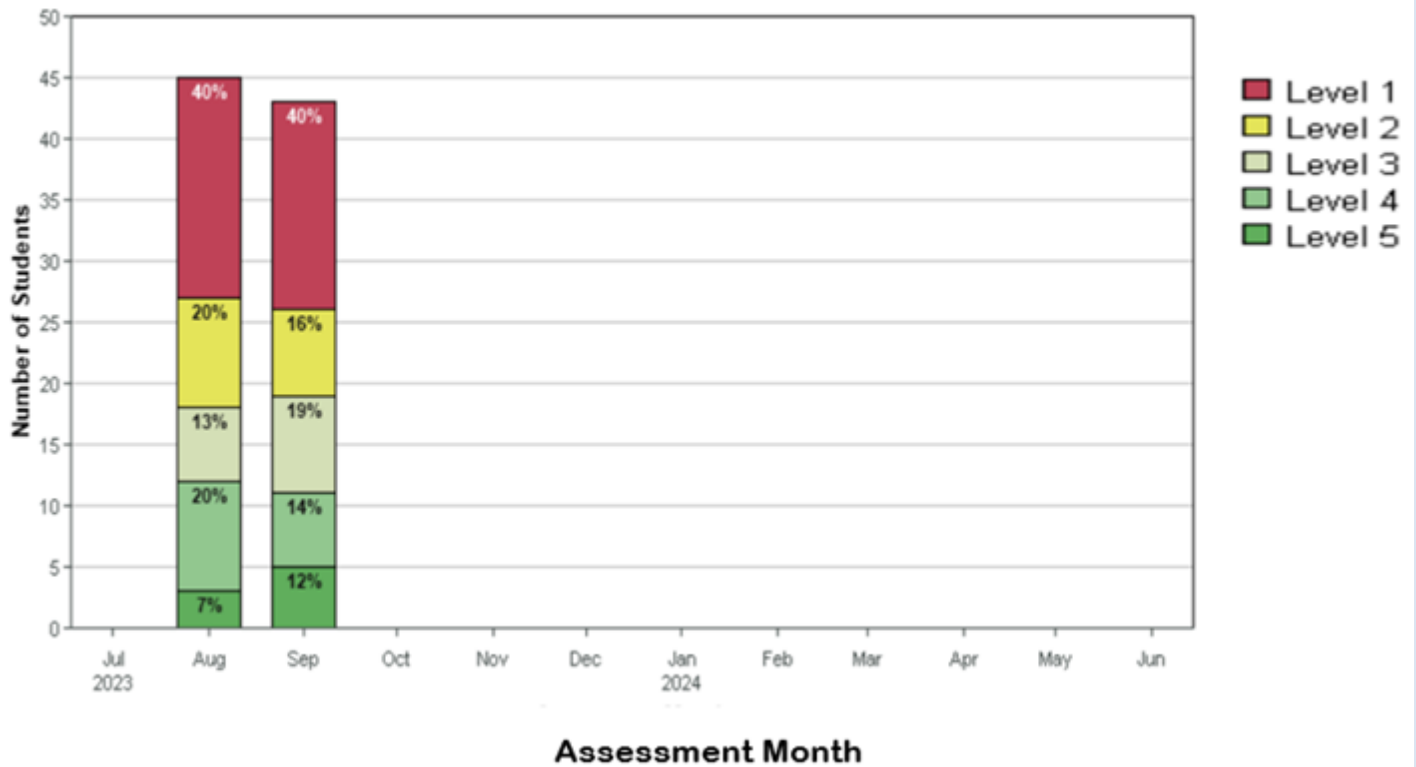
4th Grade—Overall Reading Level Movement



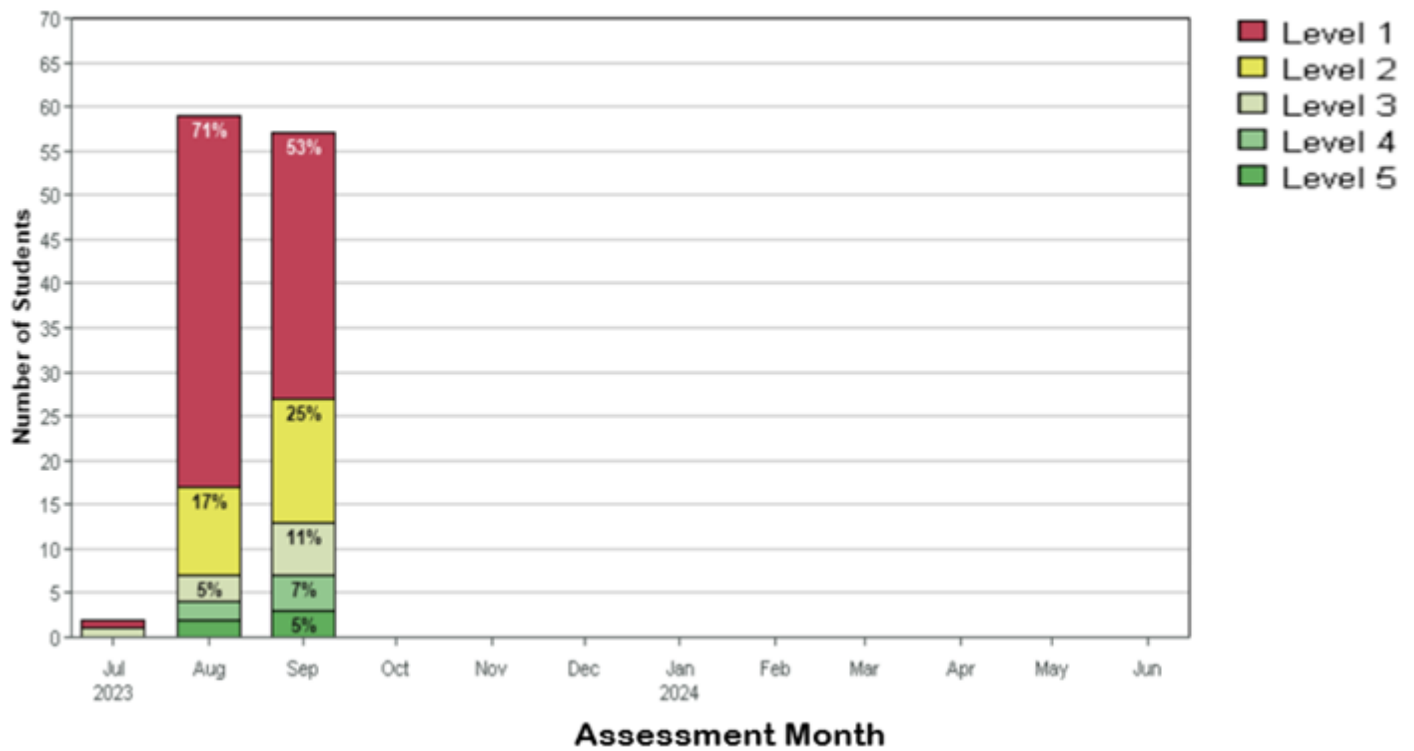
Overall Math Level Movement-Grades K-4th



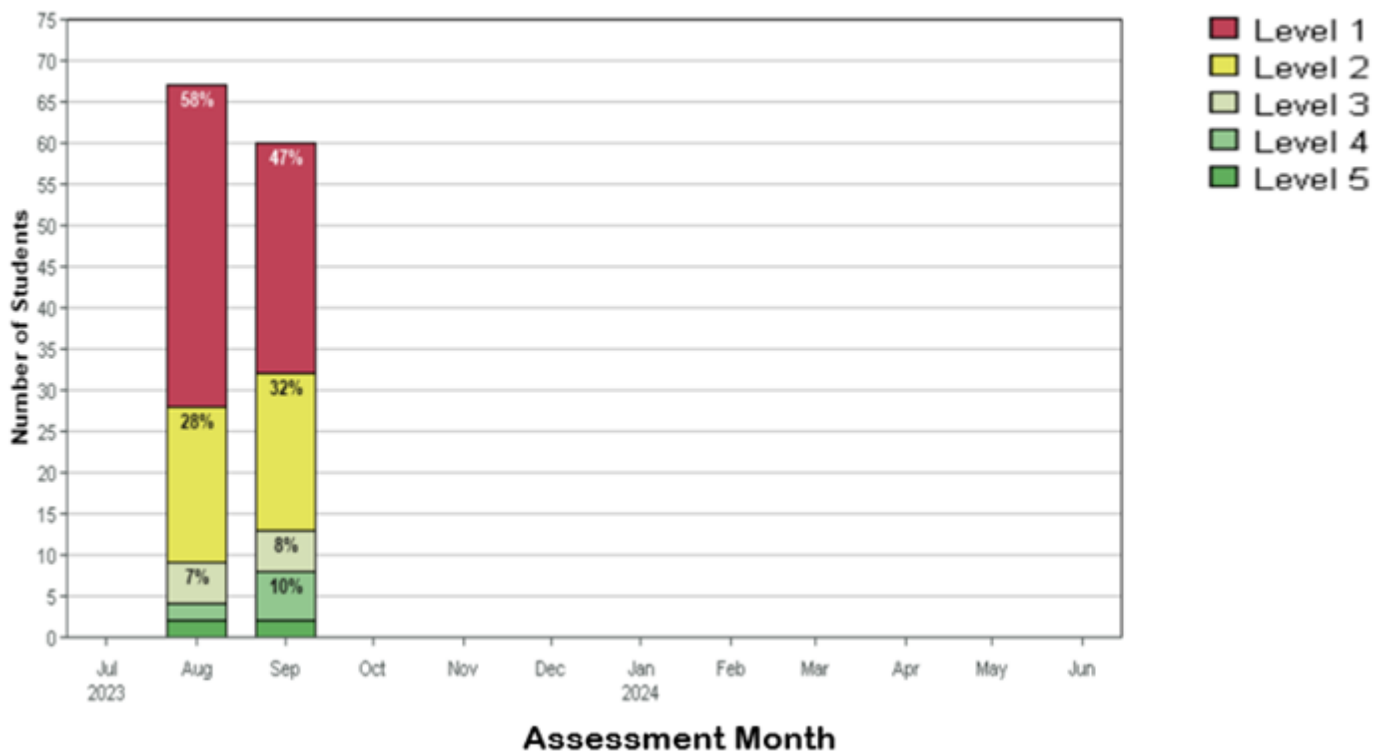
Kindergarten—Overall Math Level Movement



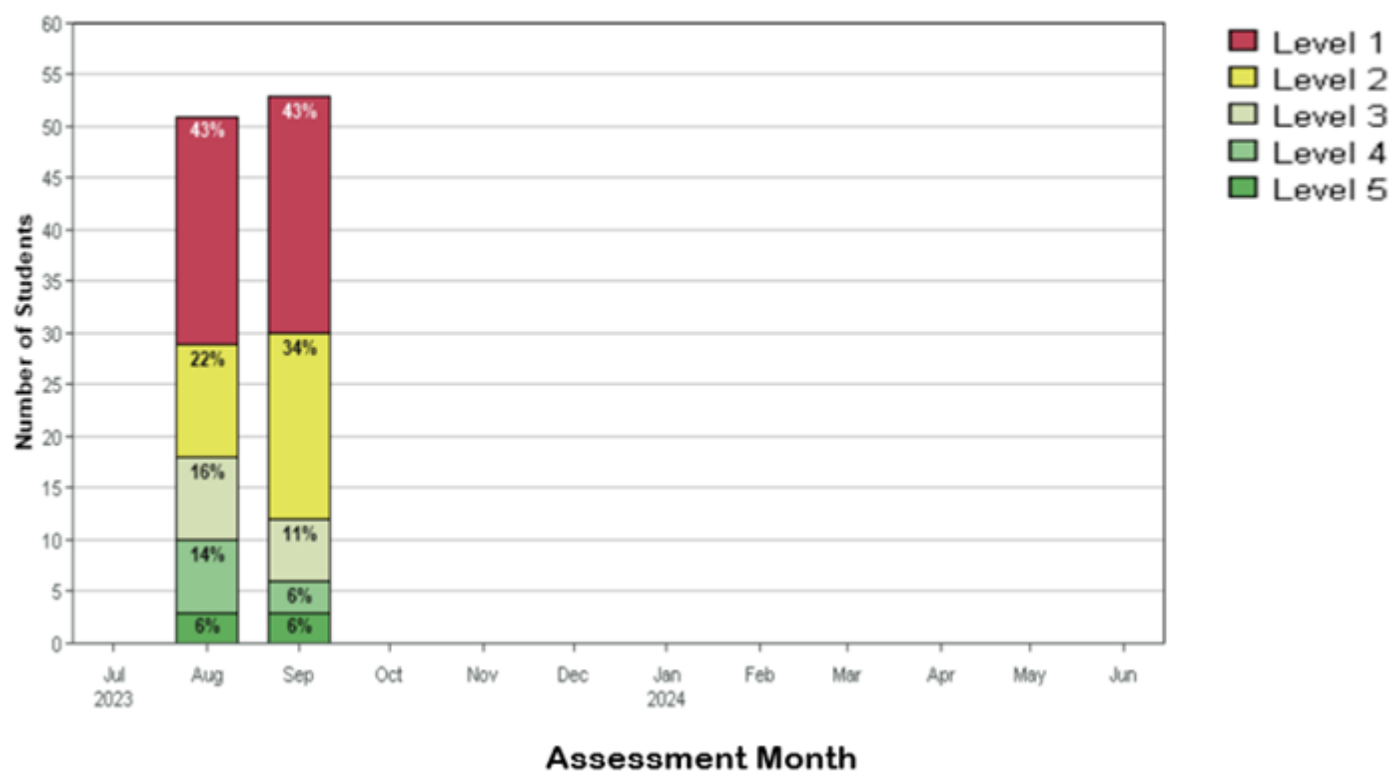
1st Grade—Overall Math Level Movement



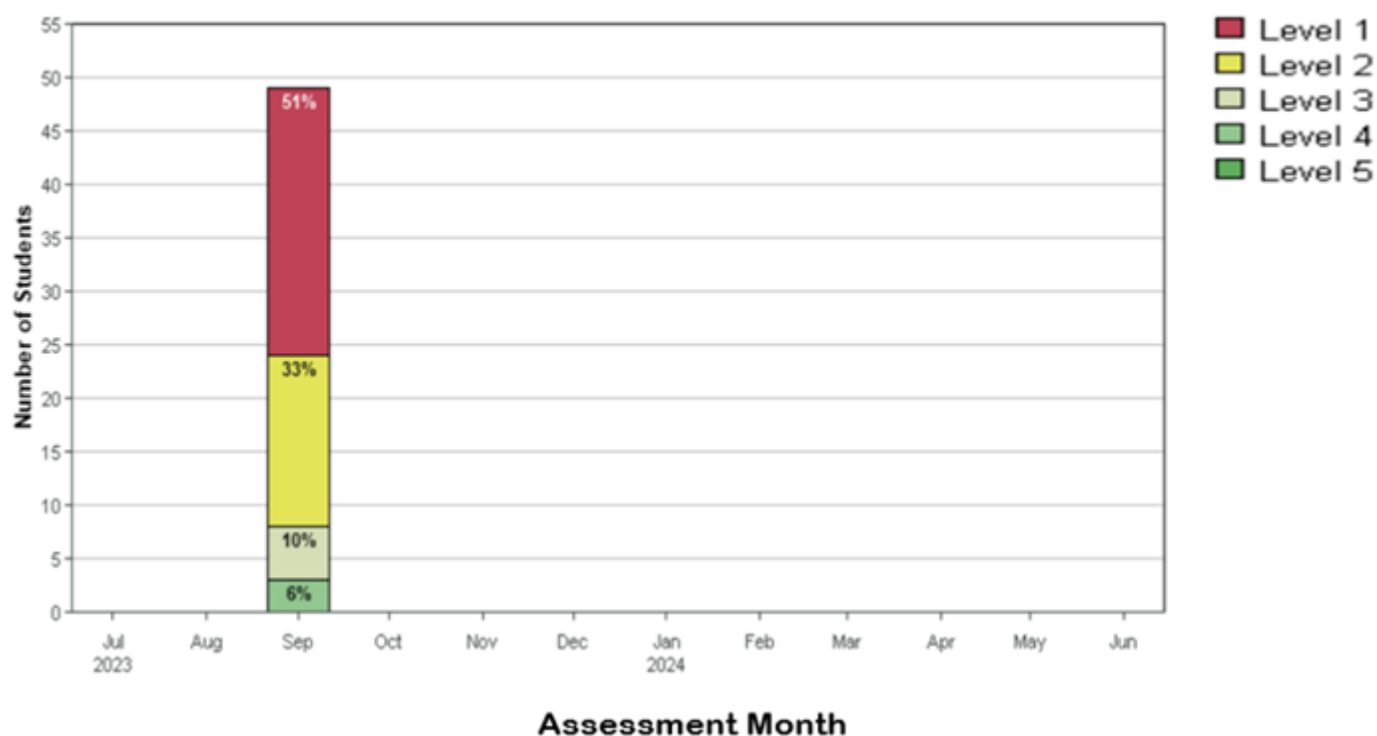
2nd Grade—Overall Math Level Movement

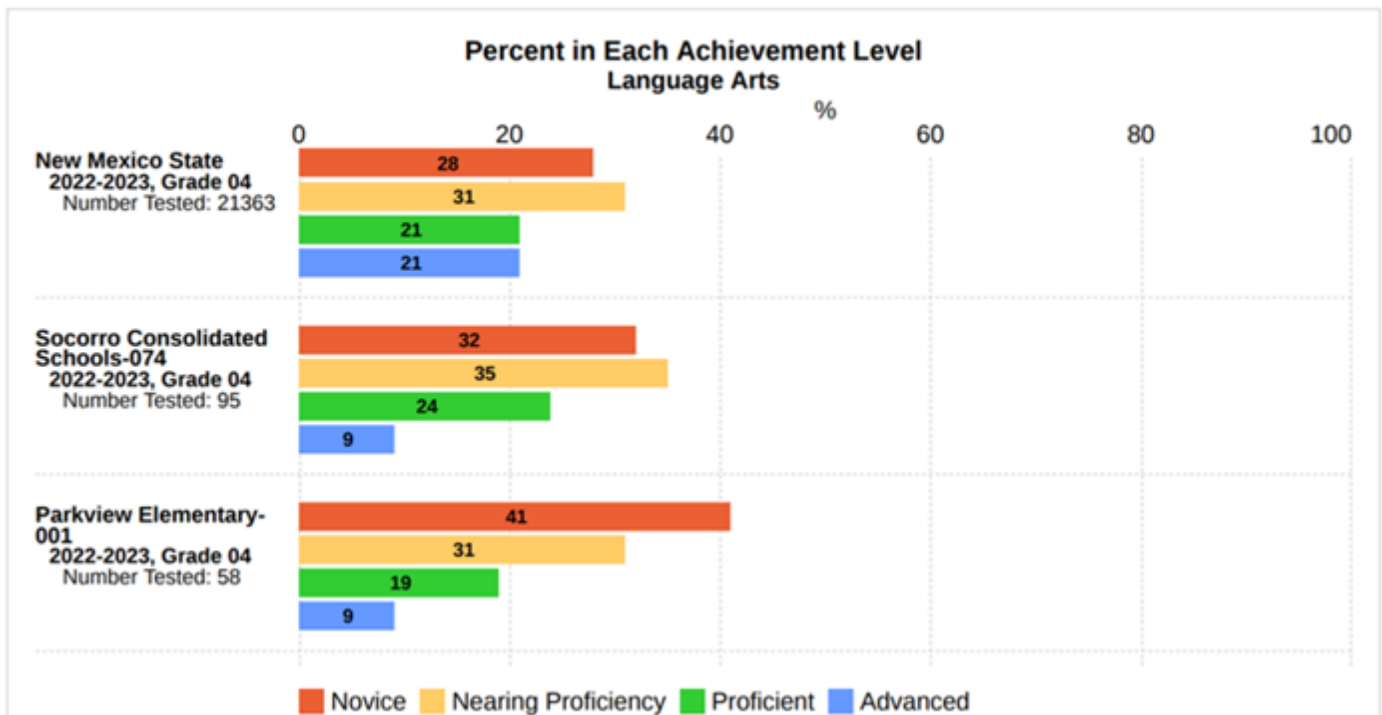

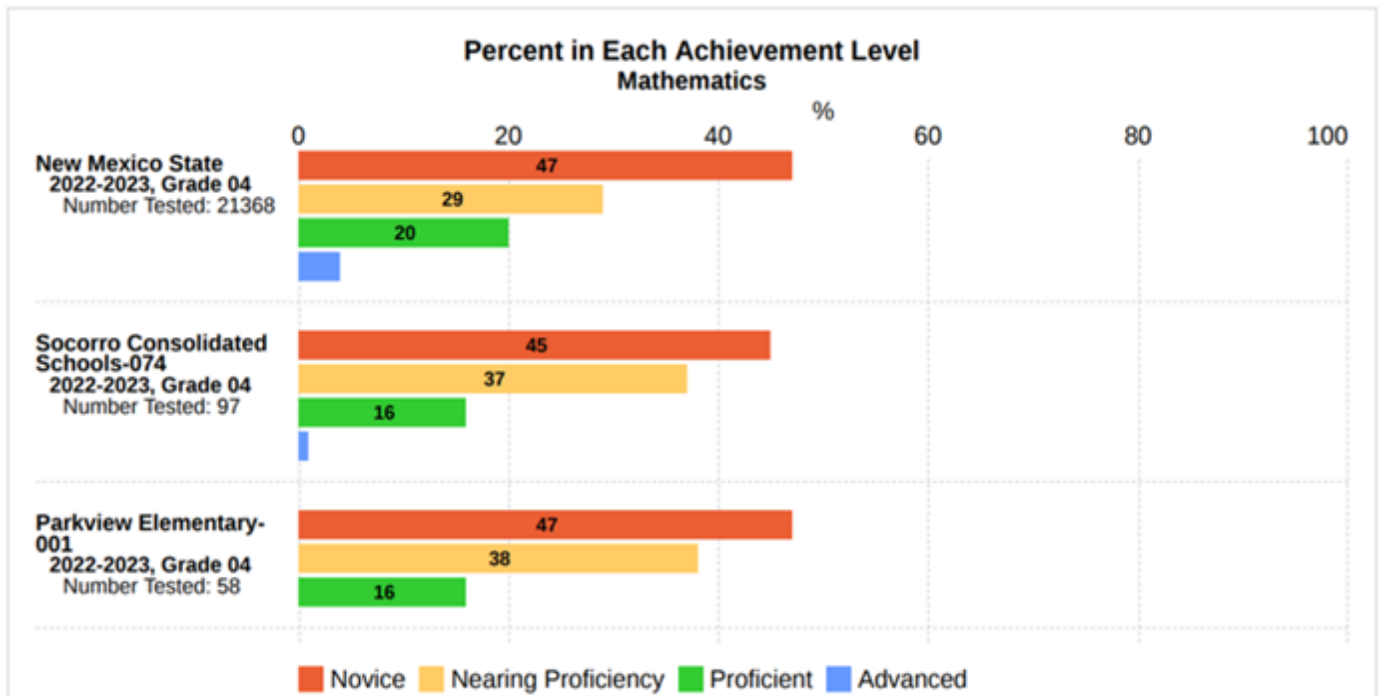
NM-MSSA Spring 2023 Mathematics Achievement Summary-3rd Grade



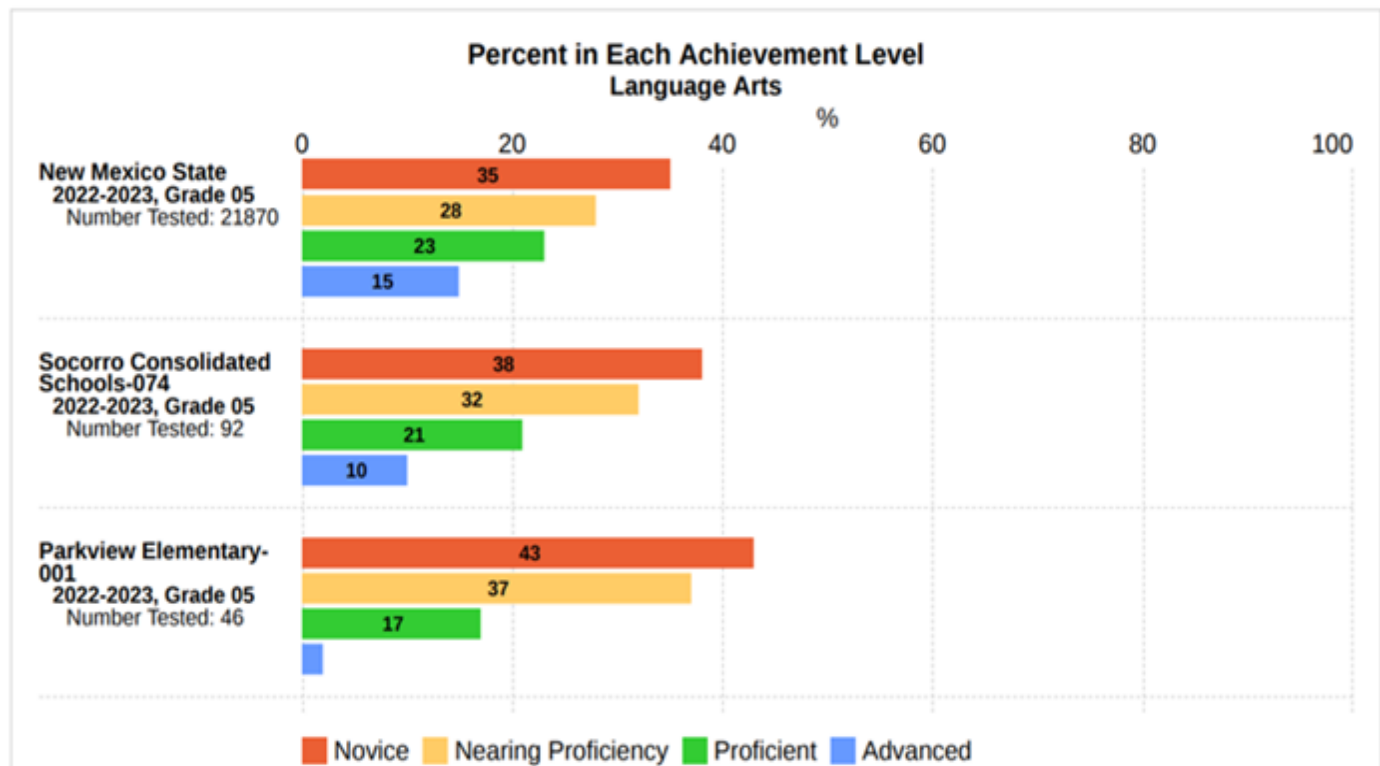

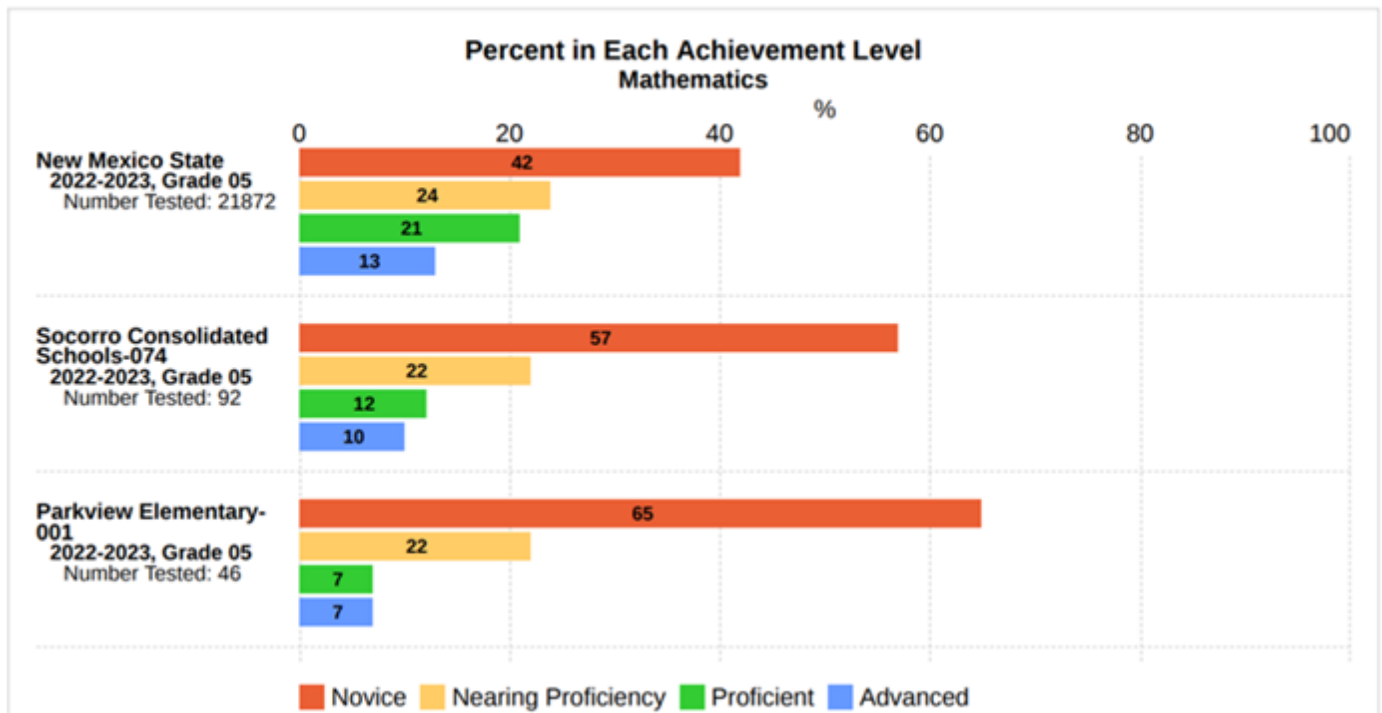

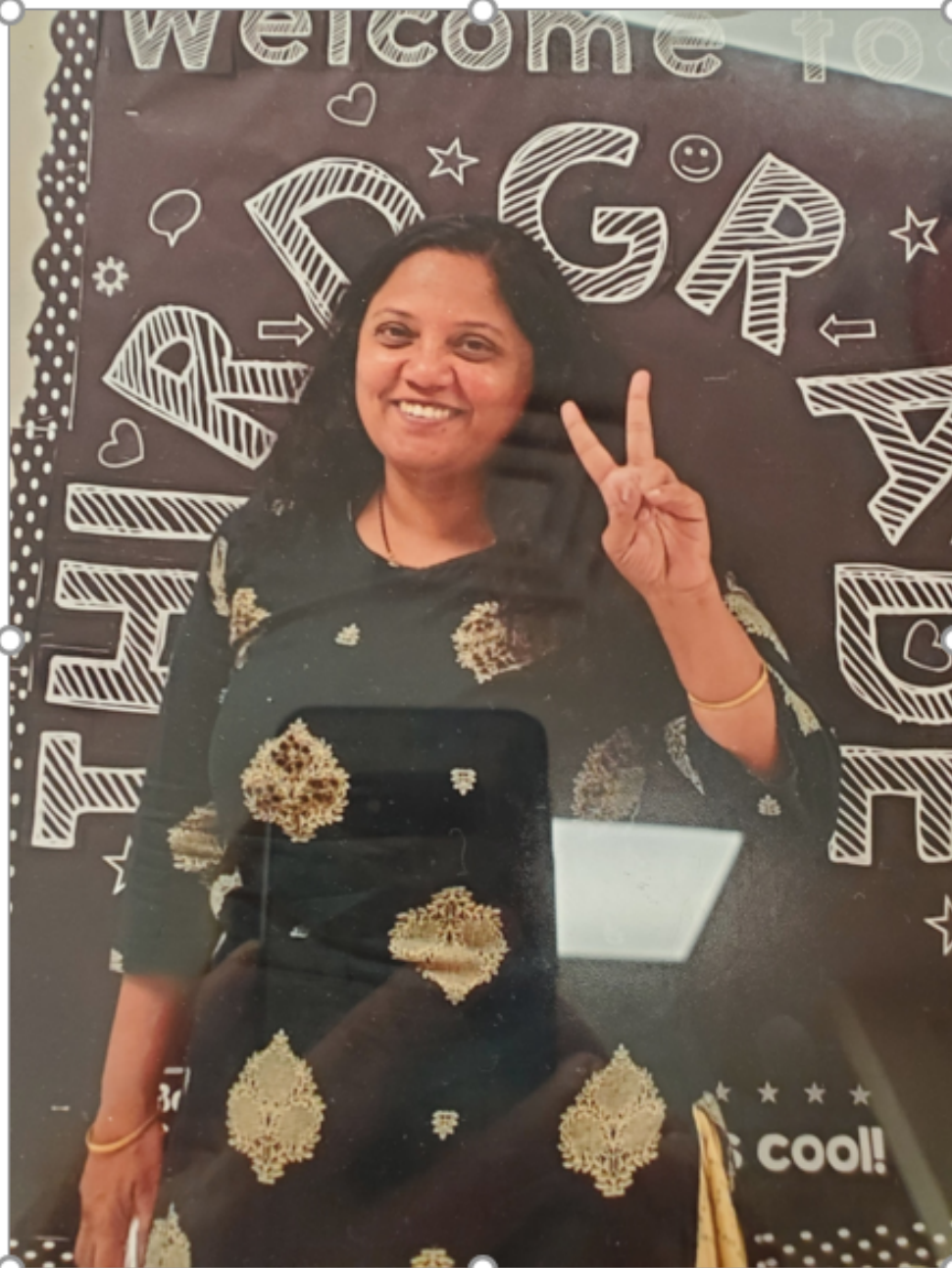
Curriculum & Instruction Update	● Parkview was awarded the 30K Literacy Grant again, for the 2023-2024 school year. This will allow the school to have a Literacy Coach, as well structured literacy materials and some training. Our new literacy coach is Ms. Michelle Williams and she is meeting with our teachers in K-5 to extend a hand in a variety of areas: ○ Creating Common Formative Assessments. ○ Helping in Professional Learning Communities. ○ Providing coverage so our teachers can observe other teachers teach. ○ And so much more. ● We formed an Attendance Team who will be working hard on attendance from the beginning of the school year. Ms. Ocampo and Ms. Herrera are both on the Attendance Team and they attended the State Attendance Conference on September 7, 2023. They focused on overcoming the barriers preventing attendance and involving people in CYFD and JPO as a part of your Attendance Team to raise the level of success in getting students back to school. (See picture below) ● LETRS training (structured literacy training) will be starting up again this month, for those who are new or who didn't complete it last year AND for our fourth grade teachers. ● Depending upon the grade level, our teachers will be engaging in Foundations Training and/or Heggerty Training—curricula that focuses on structured literacy. ● Our new teachers will be undergoing some training in PAX—our positive discipline program that we have installed on our campus. Many of them have already completed their initial training and they have commented on how great the training was. ● We are also looking forward to more MC squared training—Mathematics training that teachers engage in so that they can teach math on a more conceptual level. ● Our students are working hard in our classrooms and any areas where they are behind, we are working on getting them up to where they need to be through a variety of interventions. See pictures below. ● Our students' work is on display throughout our school. This is a great way to recognize the hard work of our students and let others know how excited our kids are about their learning. See pictures below.

Here, they learn about the flora and the fauna in our beautiful part of the world, and they become wiser about how to respect it and live harmoniously with it.

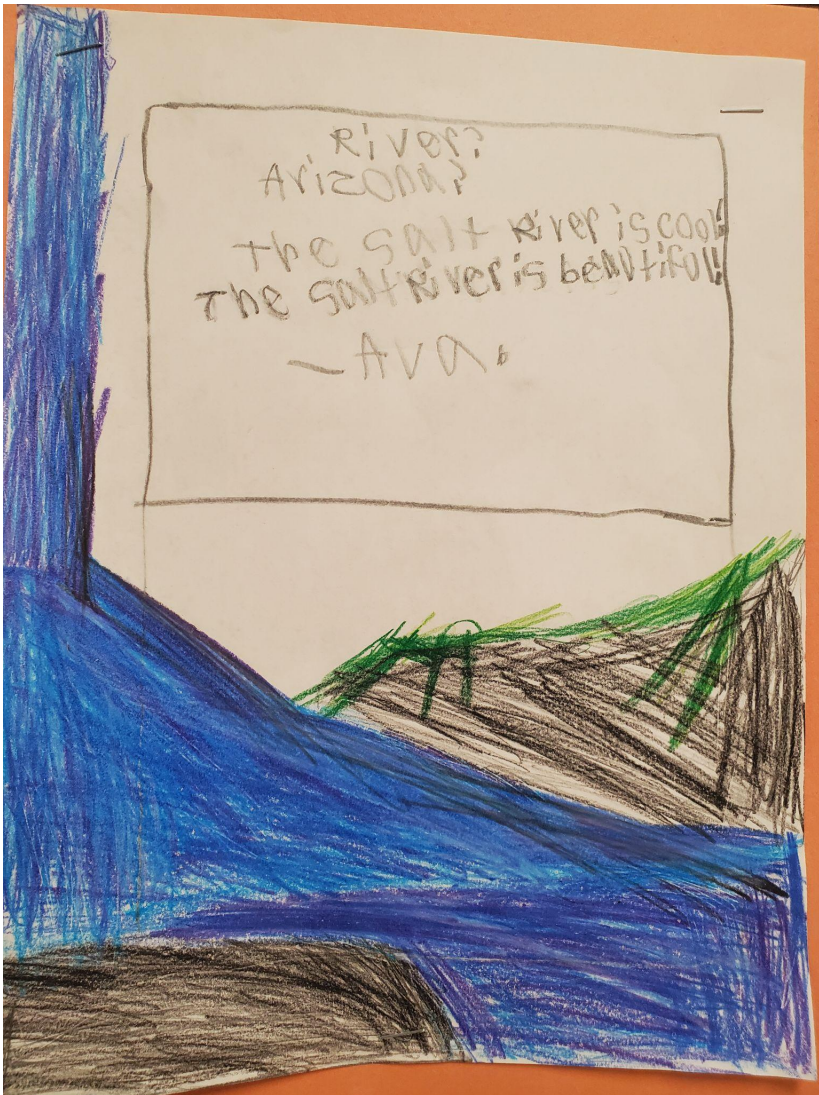
