Translational Health Data Science Fellowship Frequently Asked Questions (FAQ)

Q: Can international graduate students apply?

A: Yes, any currently enrolled graduate student can apply.

Q: If I might graduate in June 2023, can I still apply?

A: Yes, assuming you can complete the proposed research before graduation and can return for the summer research symposium. Funding support is only available while the fellow is a currently enrolled student.

Q: What if I already have a TA, or RA or similar position?

A. Please describe in the Funding Support Template your specific support, and how it will be changed to allow you to commit to this fellowship

Q: What should I do for my biosketch if I don't have an eRA Commons User Name? A: If you have an eRA Commons User Name then include that on your application. If not, you must request one from SPOeRAHelp@ucdavis.edu.

Q: I'm not a graduate student, can I apply?

A: No. You must be a currently enrolled masters or PhD student to apply for this fellowship.

Q: Can I include any funding for anybody but myself, or for service?

A: No - you can request funding for tuition, living expenses, publication expenses, or services for your elf. There is no funding for your faculty mentors or professional staff

Q: Is everything due EOB August 1?

A: Yes, everything is due by 5PM PST EOB August 1, no late submissions will be reviewed.
