Tuesday, December 10th - 6th, 7th and 8th Grade Math Benchmark (Periods 1-3)

Wednesday, December 11th - 8th Grade Social Studies Benchmark (Periods 1-3)

MPMS Period Schedule Following Testing:

Tuesday, December 10th - Periods 4, 5, 1 and 2

Wednesday, December 11th - Periods 4, 5, 6 and 7

MPMS Testing Protocols:

- NO VISITORS allowed on campus during testing days.
- Please do not schedule doctors, dentists or other appointments on testing days.
- Please ensure your student gets a good night's rest and has a nutritional breakfast.
- Please ensure your student remains in dress code (no pajamas or blankets) on testing days.
- Please ensure your student arrives on time on testing days.
- Please remind your student to secure their electronic devices (phones) in the proper testing protocol manner.
- Please encourage your students to try their best, use the instructional strategies their teachers have taught them and to show all their work and evidence on their scratch paper.
