NEXT LEVEL GROUP TRAINER

- You will **meet a total of 5 times** in correspondence with the 5 modules.
- Be sure to start on time and end on time.
- The gathering format:
 - Connect: How are you doing?
 - o Celebrate: What is exciting in your ministry/job/life tie to the competency if possible.
 - Coach: What are we here to learn about?
 - o **Communicate:** What details are needed to meet again, repeat, etc.
 - o Care: How can I pray for you?
- Answer some questions with other questions to gain untapped insight from other participants.
- Bring 1 to 2 personal insights to each session from your experience in ministry, family, or at work to add value to the discussion time.
- **Take notes** on key things your groups say and help to reiterate it throughout the conversation. What gets highlighted/celebrated gets repeated.
- Always make time to develop a list of key takeaways.
- Always be thinking about: How can I help these people grow in their leadership from this
 module; then check in with them the next time you meet on how it went and is going.
- **Verbally affirm** participation and feedback. As leaders/trainers, our words have more impact than we realize.
- **Encourage everyone to participate**; if some are not, make a special effort to draw them into the conversation. Leadership development is not a spectator sport.
- Gage the success of the module by how much others are sharing, not how much YOU are.
- As you facilitate each gathering, here are two tips and three great questions to ask yourself:
 - 1. Who are the sharp leaders or potential leaders in the group? Share this feedback with the ministry lead and encourage them to find ways to give them opportunities to grow.
 - 2. Who are the less-sharp leaders? Maybe they need to hit another round of the same level of content, the assessment of them is important as not to over-promote people.
 - Three Great Questions To Ask Participants
 - 1. What has God been saying to you in this module?
 - 2. What are you going to do about it?
 - 3. How can I as the trainer help?

- Feel free to ask more questions than solely what is listed in the homework of the module- in fact- we NEED you to ask more
- Do not edit or alter the content of each module. Each assignment and the content chosen for each module is the approved content and any edits must first be approved by Pipeline Development Team.
- Do not turn these prep group meetings into a bible study format. These modules are
 intended to have a combination of scripture, business resources/tools, videos, podcasts,
 articles, etc, so there is no need to add a scriptural reference or tie-in to each
 assignment.
