I am concerned about BUG 4 which allows me to query the calendar control to see others commitments and PII (phone numbers). Worried about scalability and mass amount of volunteers.

- Tab order of UI fields
- Commitment (states)

Bugs:

BUG 1: Usability: The Onsite dropdown should be above the text field, not the other way around

BUG 2: Delayed: Start date can be after the end date (screen 1 below)

BUG 3: Choose One string is cut off because of the size of the Type dropdown (screenshot 2 below)

BUG 4: View Checkins / List Checkins / Disaster / Filter by date allows text to be typed in the calendar control that returns results (aka 35702937582734958) -- this is serious because I can

see the PII from other people when this query executes and returns things like phone numbers -- -- I was also able to see this when VIew / Listing checkins -- is that by design?

Issues:

ISSUE 1: Security issue: Can log out as Admin on one machine and log in as another user on the same machine and it does not clear the password field.

ISSUE 2: What is the Location text field meant to contain?

ISSUE 3: Should I be able to see checkins from other people?
