Course Title: Study Skills Therapeutic

Course Description:

Study Skills Therapeutic is a Special Education support class intended for students with social-emotional needs to have time on campus to access resources to be successful in their academic classes. This class provides a regular opportunity for students to receive case manager assistance with classes and other needs, and to meet with providers. Students will also use this time to work on social-emotional, executive functioning, academic, and transition goals.

Assessment and Grading ([BP 5121](#) / [AR 5121](#)): To ensure that every student has an equal opportunity to demonstrate their learning, the course instructors implement aligned grading practices and common assessments with the same frequency.
