

The following article shall be added to the Criminal Code 2020 under Part 6, and all subsequent articles shall be renumbered appropriately.

Article 22. Seeking frivolous charges

1. A person commits the offense of seeking a frivolous charge if they:
 - a. As a private citizen, knowingly pursues criminal charges against another legal entity that are manifestly without legal merit or,
 - b. As a private citizen, fails to ensure the legal merit of criminal charges they choose to pursue against another legal entity.
2. Failure to obtain a conviction alone shall not constitute a count of seeking a frivolous charge.
3. The sentences available for seeking frivolous charges shall be a ban of up to 2 weeks.
