

The Following is a report by the Look to the Future Journalist Team.

The Galactic Senate races are heating up across the Galaxy. Almost every constituency seat in the election is being contested by both a Centralist and a Populist. Today the Look to the Future Journalist Team is bringing you our early election predictions for each Senate race.

1) Coruscant and Central

In the constituency of Coruscant and Central we see the Centralist Chancellor candidate face off against Jay Karr. Centralist Joseph Ibney has already submitted four bills to the Senate Docket all of which make major reforms to our system ensuring that our constitution is enshrined into the law. We have seen absolutely nothing of note from Populist candidate Jay Karr, and it is likely that we will not see them during the campaign either.

Look to the Future is predicting Coruscant and Central as SOLID CENTRALIST.



2) North Arrowhead



In North Arrowhead we see Centralist Candidate Sauron run unopposed. We predict that even if a late challenger jumps into the race, North Arrowhead is a SOLID CENTRALIST.



3) Inner Core

Again another race where we see only one candidate. Alderaanian Pacman Antilles is expected to win 100% of the vote due to having no opponent. We predict the Inner Core to be SOLID CENTRALIST.





4) Southern Core

The next constituency we will look at is the Southern Core. In the Southern Core we see Greejatus Haako (C) face off against Kytor Siglo (P). We have seen Kytor Siglo out and about already campaigning, but we are yet to see even an appearance from Greejatus Haako. That is why we predict the Southern Core to be SOLID POPULIST.



5) The Slice

The Slice will likely be the most exciting race to watch this election season. Centralist Leader Orson Krennic is being challenged by Populist Keicho Tame. Both candidates have been campaigning, and have been seen on the press circuit regularly for the past few days. In terms of legislation Orson Krennic has ever so slightly outdone Keicho Tame which is why we predict the Slice will be LEAN CENTRALIST.





6) New Territories

In the New Territories we see everyone's favorite Space Tunak (C) being challenged by Marcus Scipio (P). Although we wish we could predict this race in favor of Space Tunak, it is clear that with the amount of campaigning we've already seen from Marcus Scipio the Populists will likely pick up this seat. We predict the New Territories will go to the Populists as LIKELY POPULIST.



7) Western Reaches

The Western Reaches are being contested by Wilhuff Tarkin (C) and Sirus Kallo (P). The Populists will be happy to hear that because of the Centralist candidate being nowhere in sight, the Populists will easily pick up this seat. We predict the Western Reaches to be SOLID POPULIST.






8) Trailing Sectors

Our eighth and final constituency seat is the Trailing Sectors where Joseph Gunnz (C) of Naboo is facing off Ayy Tann Luroon (P) of Ryloth. We think that due to Gunnz's increased press presence and lack of legislation from Ayy Tann Luroon the Trailing Sectors constituency will see the Populist Leader defeated. We predict the Trailing Sectors to be LIKELY CENTRALIST.



9) List Seats

We will now look at the Galactic Wide List Seats. With a majority of legislation on the docket, and a wide presence in the press, we believe that the Centralists will win two of the three list seats. The Populists will be looking at one of the seats, but it is not impossible for them to win two, however we predict that it is a LIKELY CENTRALIST list seat majority of 2-1.





For the final Senate composition we predict a CENTRALIST MAJORITY of 7-4. The Populists won't be happy with this result but the Look to the Future journalist team has the only predictions of this election so far. We predict that JOSEPH IBNEY WILL BE THE NEXT SUPREME CHANCELLOR.
