- Visual product (StoryDeck, slides, Ignite, Thinglink, Prezi, PowToon etc.)
 - Uploaded to Team Lead folder (see below for technical details).
- Engagement in the Continuous Improvement process, include some of the following:
 - Equity-centered PoP statement
 - Data/evidence that lead to determining PoP
 - Hypothesis / Prediction of Change
 - Small tests of change actions taken
 - Evidence of impact
 - Learnings (Individually / Collectively)
 - Critical next steps
