***President:***

- Propose some ideas for a state theme for Convention.
- Demonstrate full administrative support at their school for hosting and conducting Saturnalia festivities for local schools (perhaps a letter from your principal, or details about the procedures you would need to follow to host an event).
- Provide a sample welcome article introducing themselves as the new state leader.

***Vice President of Membership:***

- Provide two samples of statewide engagement activities (e.g., PowerPoint presentation, Kahoot game, online contest).
- Present a concrete plan for engaging schools that are not currently part of PAJCL.

***Vice President of Public Relations:***

- Provide an example demonstrating website or media skills. (Create a mock website for Hercules, which will show such skills as linking media, organization, and presenting information in an accessible and easily comprehensible format. Provide a promotional poster for Saturnalia, make a calendar of Instagram posts for 3 months)
- Propose six themes for the Chapter of the Month contests.
- Provide a sample PAJCL chant.

***Parliamentarian:***

- Propose a plan to execute the Convention charity fundraising project.
- Identify the charity they believe PAJCL should support, provide justification, initiate contact, and include the charity's contact person and number.

***Secretary / Historian:***

- Indicate the preferred format for minute-taking.
- Propose six Photo of the Month themes related to Classical topics.

***Keystone Editor:***

- Submit a sample of previously published work in Keystone or an article based on the theme Roman Mystery.
- Create a mock of the newspaper about Roman Historical Events around 509 BC in the format of your choosing.
