Trooper Youth Week

Trooper Youth Week is a residential youth education program developed by the New Jersey State Police. This program presents simulated law enforcement training for **male and female** students who have completed their junior year and are entering their senior year of High School. Additionally, sophomores who are currently 17 years of age may also be eligible. The applicant must not have reached their 18th birthday prior to the graduation date of their Trooper Youth Week class.

The week's activities include lectures and presentations covering many facets of police work and criminal justice. Participants will be exposed to a disciplined quasi-military environment, including military drill in

combination with structured fast moving programs of classroom activities, lectures, films, practical exercises and physical training, simulating the NJSP recruit training experience.

The program emphasizes courtesy, professionalism, respect, and teamwork. Additional presentations will include strategies for anger management, conflict resolution and cultural diversity.
