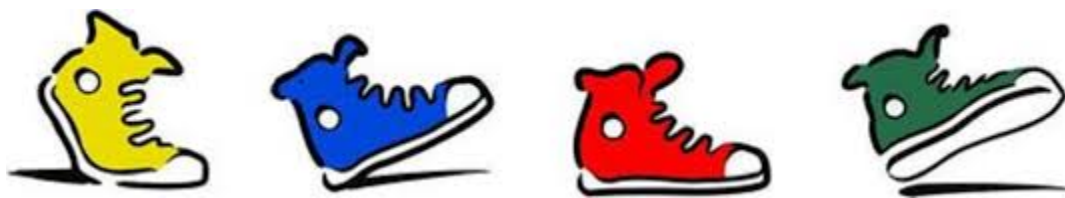

I wanted to take this opportunity to inform you of something we are continuing to implement this year. As always, the health and safety of our students is our top priority. Lakeshore Elementary Schools are using screening tools to help identify students in need of additional social and emotional support services. Each teacher will complete a rating scale for each student in their classroom. This tool allows the teachers to identify students social and emotional strengths and areas for growth. An additional tool will also be used with students in 4th and 5th grade. This will provide an opportunity for them to tell us about their feelings and behaviors, and to get connected with social and emotional support.
