

NATEODA Candidate for DIRECTOR: Eugene “Gene” Squires



Gene entered the United States Army on active duty in May 1976 and retired in June 2004, with a majority of assignments to Explosive Ordnance Disposal positions, and a retirement rank of Sergeant Major. Subsequently, he was employed as SRA International's Director, Combating Terrorism, performing work for the Army Staff's G-3 Director of Military Support on homeland defense requirements of prioritized critical defense infrastructure and defense support to civil authorities, and work for the Army's Improvised Explosive Device Task Force on designing the Army's Asymmetric Warfare Group.

Gene is a founding partner of Squires & Fulcher, LLC, a management consultant company incorporated June 15, 2005, in Georgia, working with corporate-suite clients on crafting strategy and program execution for increasing shareholder growth or mission accomplishment.
